



ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT NO. 1 IN Cri.M.A. NO.72/2026
(Subedar harishchand Pal Vs. The State of Maharashtra)

1. This is an application for return of property seized by the State Police Station, Mangrulpir, Dist. Washim. But the Investigating Officer and A.P.P. have objected to release the seized property.
2. Heard. Read the application and say. Perused the documents filed along with it. The application is supported by the affidavit of the applicant.
3. The State Police Station Mangrulpir, police have seized TATA MOTORS LTD. its Registration No. UP-70-PT-0338, Chassis No.MAT790020R7E08428, Engine No. 5LNGDICR34EVX511597 in Crime No.424/2026 registered vide Under Section 106(1), 125(a) & 281 of BNS and Under Section 184 of M.V. Act. The applicant had filed the following documents :-
 - (a) The copy of the certificate of registration of said vehicle.
 - (b) The xerox copy of Transport Permit.
 - (c) The xerox copy of applicant's Aadhar Card.
 - (d) The copy of Insurance.
 - (e) The copy of F.I.R.
4. From the above documents, applicant appears to be owner of the seized six wheeler vehicle. No purpose would be served in keeping the said vehicle lying in the Police Station. The possibility of the damage to the property can not be ruled out if kept lying in the Police Station. The trial would not be concluded in near future. Moreover, the police have taken sufficient time to finish their procedure.

5. In view of discussions supra, I am of the considered opinion that the applicant is entitled for the possession of the seized vehicle. In the result following order is passed.

ORDER

- 1) The application is allowed.
- 2) The State Police Station, Mangrulpir have seized property viz. TATA MOTORS LTD. its Registration No. UP-70-PT-0338, Chassis No.MAT790020R7E08428, Engine No. 5LNGDICR34EVX511597 in Crime No.424/2026 be handed over to the applicant viz. Subedar Harshchand Pal, R/o. Tilhapur Block Nawada, Tal. Chachal, Dist. Kaushambi (Uttar Pradesh) till the conclusion of the trial on the applicant executing indemnity bond of Rs. 5,00,000/- (Five Lakh only).
- 3) The applicant to undertake that he shall not sell or alienate or transfer the said vehicle without the prior permission of the Court.
- 4) The applicant shall produce the said vehicle in the Court as and when directed.
