1. This is an application under section 12 of Domestic Violence Act claiming various reliefs.
2. Heard learned advocate for the applicant at length. Perused the record.
3. The present proceeding is filed against in all six respondents. On perusal of the allegations made in the application/petition it appears that respondent No.05 & 06 are not the family members of respondent No.01 to 04. Respondent No. 05 & 06 are resident near Belora Airport, Badnera, Dist- Amravati. It appears that there is no domestic relationship in between applicant and respondent No.05 & 06. In the petition/application, vague and general allegations are made against them. It is no where stated in the application that respondent No.05 & 06 are resided in the shared household with applicant. Thus, there is no case made out for issuance of notice against respondent No.05 & 06. So far as, respondent No. 01 to 04 are concerned, there are specific allegations regarding domestic violence against them. It is alleged that, respondent No. 01 to 04 are the members of joint family. Hence, order

ORDER

1. Issue notice to the respondent No.01 to 04 through protection officer returnable on 23/01/2026.
2. The application/petition dismissed against respondent No.05 & 06.
