

ORDER BELOW EXH. 22 IN P.W.D.VA. NO.33/2023

(Dipali @ Sonu Sunil Pawar Vs. Sunil Subhash Pawar and ors.)

(CNR No. MHWS-040013982023)

1) This is an application made by non-applicants for setting aside “No Say” order passed against them. Applicant has taken strongly objection.

2) Heard, Read the application and say. Perused the record and proceeding. Non-applicants appear through their advocate. Thereafter, non-applicants failed to file say. Therefore, No Say order passed against non-applicants Nos. 1, 3 to 5 on 24/07/2025 and ex-parte order passed against non-applicant No.2. Non-applicants contended in their application that they could not file their Say within time due to non-applicants out of town for labour work.

3) It is well settled that opportunity of natural justice should be given to everyone. It is also well settled that no one should be condemned unheard. In order to enable the court to effectively decide the matter, it is necessary to set aside “No Say” order against non-applicant No.1, 3 to 5 and to set aside ex-parte against non-applicant No.2 order. It is, therefore, necessary in the interest of justice to allow the application. Hence, I proceed to pass following order.

Order

- 1 The application is allowed subject to cost of Rs. 1000/- (One Thousand Only) to be paid to applicant.
2. Costs shall be paid on or before next date.
