

Order below Exh.20 & 21

- 1] Perused the application and say. Heard both counsels.
- 2] In this case, Claimant Govind had instituted this case for compensation. During the proceedings he died. The applicants preferred this application for bringing them on record as LR's and condonation of delay. The perusal of the application shows that the LR's of Govind were ignorant about the litigation filed by him. There is no any other material against their contention except the bare words of other side. In such circumstance, I am of the view that the delay is required to be condoned. It is apparent that the applicants are LR's of deceased Govind. The legal heir certificate issued by the Civil Judge Junior Division, Mangrulpir makes it clear. There is no hurdle in condoning the delay and bringing the LR's on record. Hence, I am inclined to pass the following order.

ORDER

- 1] The application is hereby allowed.
- 2] The delay in preferring the application for bringing the LR's on record is hereby condoned.
- 3] The applicants be arrayed as LR's of deceased Govind.
- 4] The applicants to pay the costs of Rs.200/- to non-applicant no.1.
- 5] The LR's be brought on record within 14 days.
