

ORDER BELOW EXH-18
(Passed on 19.01.2026)

The applicants filed the application under order VI Rule 17 of the Code of Civil Procedure for making amendment.

2. It was their contention that inadvertently in para No.2 of the main application, applicant No.1 to 4 was mentioned instead of applicant No.1 to 3. Further, non-applicant No.1 to 3 are legal heirs of deceased Anandgir Giri who remarried after the death of first wife Antakala and married with Indubai non-applicant No.1. That non-applicant No.2 and 3 are legal heirs of deceased Anandgir Giri from non-applicant No.1 and non-applicant No.4 and 5 are legal heirs of deceased from his previous wife Antakala. Hence, prayed for necessary amendment.

3. Per contra, the learned advocate for non-applicant strongly opposed the application and submitted that application is not tenable. Hence, be rejected.

4. Perused the application, say and record. Heard learned advocate for applicant. From the contents of application it reveals that applicant is trying to clarify the relations of applicant, non-applicant with deceased Anandgir Giri.

5. Considered the rival submission of both the parties. It seems to me that the amendment sought is necessary for the fair and final adjudication of the present matter, and no

prejudice will cause to the non-applicant if the said amendment as sought is allowed, further more the present amendment does not change the nature of application and it appears necessary to decide real controversy between the parties and to avoid multiplicity of proceeding and thus I proceed to pass the following order in the interest of justice.

ORDER

- 1) Application Exh.18 is hereby allowed.
- 2) Applicant is hereby directed to carry out the necessary amendment within 14 days from the date of this order.
