



ORDER BELOW EXH.1

This is an application for grant of Heir-ship Certificate under Bombay Regulation Act 1827.

2] According to the applicants, applicant No.1 is wife, applicant No.2 & 3 are children and applicant No.4 is mother of deceased namely **Sunil Vasanta Sarkate** who was died on 31/12/2025. Therefore, applicants are only legal heirs of deceased **Sunil Vasanta Sarkate**. Except applicants no any other persons are legal heirs of deceased. The applicants required heir-ship certificate for recording their name on Government office as well as Semi Government Office. Hence, this application for grant of heir-ship certificate.

3] After filing of application, the public notice was given as regards heir-ship and it was duly published in the newspaper "Punya-Nagari" dated 18/02/2026 at **Exh.16**. In response to said public notice, no one appeared or filed objection to the claim of heir-ship of applicants.

4] In support of their claim, applicant No.1 has filed affidavit of examination-in-chief at Exh.10. She has categorically stated that, applicants are only legal heirs of deceased Sunil Vasanta Sarkate. The applicants have filed on record documents viz. verified copy of death certificate of deceased Sunil Vasanta Sarkate at **Exh.11**. Verified copies of Aadhar cards at **Exh.12 to 14** and verified copy of birth certificate of applicant No.3 Arushi Sunil Sarkate at **Exh.15**. Applicants have closed

their evidence by filing pursis at **Exh.18**.

5] After considering the pleading, evidence of applicants, documents on record and submission of learned counsel for the applicants, this Court is of the opinion that issuance of heir-ship certificate is merely formal recognition as an heirs of deceased. It appears from record that applicants are only legal heirs of deceased **Sunil Vasanta Sarkate**. Admittedly, name of the competent legal heirs ought to be recorded in the official record and revenue record. There is no denial to the rights of applicants. All the documents and evidence before Court is sufficient to issue heir-ship certificate in the name of applicants being heirs. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order:

::ORDER::

- 1] The application is allowed.
- 2] Issue Heir-ship Certificate in the name of applicants declaring them to be recognized heirs of deceased **Sunil Vasanta Sarkate** on depositing requisite Court fee Stamp as per rules.
