Application for Grant of Legal Heirship Certificate Under Bombay Regulation VIII
of 1827

JUDGMENT

(Delivered on 02/05/2026)

This application is filed for grant of Heirship Certificate under Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827.

2. It is contentions of applicants that on 18/12/2025 Shaikh Badal Shaikh Kadar died. Applicant No.1 is widow and applicant Nos. 2 to 6 are children of deceased Shaikh Badal. Mother of deceased Shaikh Badal is already died. All applicants are required heirship certificate for the use of Government and semi Government purpose. Therefore, all applicants filed present application for grant of legal heirship certificate.

3. In support of their contentions the applicant No.1 Hamidabi Badal Shek filed her evidence of affidavit at Exh.8 and averted as per contents of the application. Applicants have filed on record original death certificate of deceased Shaikh Badal Shaikh Kadar at Exh.09, verified copy of Aadhaar Card of applicant Nos.1 to 6 at Exh.10 to 15, respectively and paper publication in daily news paper 'Dainik Shivvichar' dated 23/01/2026 at Exh.16.

4. It is seen from the documents filed on record that on 18/12/2025 Shaikh Badal Shaikh Kadar died.

5. The public notice was issued in daily news paper Dainik Shivvichar on 23/01/2026. However, no one has taken an objection in respect of said paper publication. The testimony of applicant No.1 Hamidabi Shek is remained unchallenged and is corroborated with the contents of the application. The documentary evidence also supports the case of applicants. Hence, I hold that applicants are legal heirs of the deceased Shaikh Badal Shaikh Kadar. Thus, in the answer to the aforesaid discussion, I pass the following order :-

ORDER

1. The application is allowed.
2. Issue Legal Heirship Certificate in name of applicants 1) Hamidabi Badal Shek, 2) Aafreen Parveen Shaikh Badal, 3) Amreen Parveen Shaikh Badal, 4) Neha Parvin Shaikh Badal, 5) Shaikh Rehan Shaikh Badal and 6) Shaikh Ridan Shaikh Badal as legal heirs of deceased Shaikh Badal Shaikh Kadar as per the provisions of Bombay Regulation, VIII of 1827.

3. Applicants are directed to supply requisite stamp duty for legal heirship certificate.
