JUDGMENT

(Delivered on 25/06/2026)

This application is filed for grant of Heirship Certificate under Bombay Regulation VIII of 1827.

2. It is contentions of applicants that on 09/10/1998 Kashinath Anandrao Gangawne died. On 28/07/2023 Mangalabai Kashinath Gangawne died. Applicants are children of deceased Kashinath and deceased Mangalabai. Mother of deceased Kashinath already died. All applicants are required heirship certificate for Government and Semi-government purpose. Therefore, all applicants filed present application for grant of legal heirship certificate.

3. In support of their contentions the applicant no.1 Jayant Gangawne filed his evidence of affidavit at Exh.13 and averred as per contents of the application. Applicants have filed on record original death certificate of deceased Kashinath and deceased Mangalabai, at Exh.14 and 15, respectively, verified copy of Aadhaar Card of applicant no.1 to 4 at Exh.16 to 19, respectively, and paper publication in daily news paper 'Dainik Punyanagari' dated 15/02/2026 at Exh.20.

4. It is seen from the documents filed on record that on 09/10/1998 Kashinath Anandrao Gangawne died. It is also seen from the documents filed on record that on 28/07/2023 Mangalabai Kashinath Gangawne died.

5. The public notice was issued in daily news paper Dainik Punyanagari on 15/02/2026. However, no one has taken an objection in respect of said paper publication. The testimony of applicant no.1 Jayant Gangawne is remained unchallenged and is corroborated with the contents of the application. The documentary evidence also supports the case of applicants. Hence, I hold that applicants are legal heirs of the deceased Kashinath Anandrao Gangawne and Mangalabai Kashinath Gangawne. Thus, in the answer to the aforesaid discussion, I pass the following order :-

ORDER

1. The application is allowed.
2. Issue Legal Heirship Certificate in name of applicants 1) Jayant Kashinath Gangawne, 2) Balwant Kashinath Gangawne, 3) Sunita Sanjay Ghuge and 4) Anita Vinayak Sanap as legal heirs of deceased Kashinath Anandrao Gangawne and Mangalabai Kashinath Gangawne as per the provisions of Bombay Regulation, VIII of 1827.
3. Applicants are directed to supply requisite stamp duty for legal heirship certificate.
