ORDER BELOW EXH-20
(Passed on 06.01.2026)

Plaintiff filed the application for extension or continuation of status-quo. He submits that defendant No.2 appeared today before the Court. But senior counsel is not present for arguing on Exh.5. If the extension of status-quo is not granted he may suffer irreparable loss.

2. The defendant strongly opposed the said application and submits that vide Exh.40 status-quo is granted till filing say of defendant No.1 and vide Exh.70 status-quo is extended till appearance defendant No.2 and 3. Today all defendants were present and defendant No.1 has filed his say to the application below Exh.5 and ready to argue on Exh.5. Hence, present application be rejected.

3. Heard both the learned advocates at considerable length. The say of defendant No.2 and 3 was not filed on record in respect of application below Exh.5. Moreover, vide Exh.21 defendant No.1 sought time to file their say on record. Considering the circumstances in respect of say of defendant No.2 and 3 I deemed it proper to extend status-quo to the plaintiff till next date to avoid multiplicity of proceeding.
