

Order below Exhibit No.34
(Passed on 12th March 2026)

On 4/03/2025, the predecessor of this Tribunal has passed order and thereby allowed Non-applicant No.2 (Insurance Company) to issue summons to the witness, subject to payment of Bhatta of Rs.4,000/- to be deposited in the court and also for crediting the same in the account of the Government. However, till today, i.e. after more than one year, non-applicant No.2 (Insurance Company) has not complied with this order.

2. Apart from this, today, Insurance Company and its counsel both are absent, though called repeatedly till 3.30 p.m. and till this period, no application is filed by the Insurance Company. Considering all these aspects, it seems that Insurance Company is not willing to proceed with this application and is also not willing to deposit the Bhatta, as directed.

3. However, as a last chance Insurance Company is directed to deposite the amount of above referred Bhatta in the court, on next date, without fail, failing in which, this application stands automatically rejected for not depositing the amount of Bhatta.

4. Insurance Company and its Advocate to note and comply.
