ORDER BELOW EXH. 2

1. This is an application for bail under Section 483 of the Bhartiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
2. Heard the learned counsel for the accused and the learned PP for the State. Perused the record.
3. It is submitted by the learned counsel for the accused that the accused has been behind the bars since 17/09/2025. Chargesheet is filed. The family of the accused is facing hardship.
4. *Per contra*, it is submitted by the learned PP that there is the direct involvement of accused and there is *prima-facie* case against him. There is the possibility of pressurizing the witnesses and reoccurrence of similar crime.
5. The perusal of the FIR reflects that the allegations leveled therein are to the extent that while the informant and two other girls, aged between 17 to 18 years, were awaiting a bus at a bus-stand, the accused moved his pant downwards and showed his private part to the girls and made obscene gestures towards them. Though the girls moved aside, the accused repeated similar act.

6. The allegations leveled against the accused are serious in nature, inasmuch as he is alleged to have shown his private part to the teenager school going girls. In such scenario, the accused does not deserve to be enlarged on bail.

7. Thus, I proceed to pass the following order.

ORDER

The application is hereby rejected.
