ORDER BELOW EXHIBIT-1

This application has been filed by applicant/accused by name Ragib Ahamad s/o Abdul Rab for grant of regular bail in Crime No. 27/2026, registered with Police Station Shirpur for the offence punishable under Section 8(c), 21(c), 22(c) and 29 of N.D.P.S. Act.

02. Heard learned Advocate for the applicant Mr. P. M. Pathan and learned A.P.P. Mr. R. D. More, perused the application, documents annexed, say/reply filed by I.O. through learned A.P.P. at Exh. 5. Also perused the case-diary produced today by Ld. APP and the copy of charge-sheet produced by learned Advocate for applicant.

03. Upon considering rival submissions in the light of material emerged from the case-diary and charge-sheet, it appears that from the possession of this applicant on 19/02/2026 at about 8.30 p.m. contraband MD (Mephedrone) having weight of 06.07 Gms. including weight of polythene of 0.87 milligram was found and was seized. It is the submission on behalf of applicant by his learned Advocate that this 06.07 Gms. MD comes under the

ambit of intermediate quantity and thus does not come under the commercial quantity. It is also submitted on behalf of applicant that there is no antecedents to his credit and he is a young boy of 25 years of age having permanent resident of Lalguda, Wani, Tq. Wani, Dist. Yavatmal and behind bars since 20/02/2026.

04. Now, the investigation is completed and charge-sheet is filed. Applicant has faced the custodial interrogation. Already one co-accused has been released on regular bail. Considering the quantity of contraband seized from this applicant bar of Section 37 of N.D.P.S. Act is not applicable and attracted.

05. It does not appear from the submissions made and material emerged that this applicant is having any antecedent to his credit. Presence of this applicant for trial can be secured by imposing certain conditions in view of his place of abode. Trial has not yet started. Definitely certain considerable time would consume to conclude the trial on merits in view of pendency of old U.T.P. trials and old matters. No purpose would be served by keeping the applicant behind bars for uncertain period in view of above discussion in the light of overall facts as emerged in his respect. Already one co-accused in the crime has been released on bail. In view of material emerged whether the offences are made out or not would be decided after full fledged trial and not at this stage.

06. Hence, applicant has made out a case for regular bail on certain stringent conditions and restrictions. Thus, this application is liable to be allowed on certain stringent conditions and restrictions. As a result the following order -

ORDER

1. Application Exh.1 is allowed.
2. Applicant/accused Ragib Ahamad s/o Abdul Rab be released on PR and SB of Rs.50,000/- in Crime No. 27/2026, registered with Police Station Shirpur for the offences punishable under Section 8(c),21(c), 22(c) and 29 of the N.D.P.S. Act.
3. Applicant shall not commit similar type of offence or any cognizable offence while on bail.
4. Applicant shall attend the trial on each and every date unless exempted and shall not protract the trial due to his absence in any manner.
5. Applicant shall furnish all details of his residential address to the Court while submitting surety and shall also inform any change in his residential address immediately to the Court.
6. Applicant shall not make any contact with any prosecution witnesses in any manner.
7. Applicant shall not hamper or tamper and pressurise the any prosecution witnesses and/or prosecution evidence in any manner.
8. Applicant shall not leave the country till completion of trial.
9. The prosecution is at liberty to apply for cancellation of bail in event of breach of any condition as mentioned above by

the applicant.

10. Surety to submit before learned Trial Court.

11. Humdast granted.
