ORDER BELOW EXH.01 IN S.C.C. NO.127/2018

Today the complainant present before the court along with his counsel. The complainant has filed withdrawal pursis at Exh.38 along with copy of his Adhar Card at Exh.39. In the pursis mentioned that, the matter has been settled by mutual settlement. The accused has returned the full amount. The complainant wants to withdraw. The complainant received the cheque amount from the accused. Therefore, the complainant does not want further proceed with the matter.

2. The contents of withdraw pursis at Exh.38 read over and explained to the complainant, he admits the same. It appears that, the complainant not want to proceed with the matter, there is no meaning to keep matter pending. Therefore, it is just and appropriate to disposed of the matter as per withdraw pursis at Exh.38. Hence, I pass the following order :-

ORDER

1. The matter is withdrawn in view of withdrawal pursis vide Exh.38 and be disposed off accordingly.

2. The accused is acquitted for the offence punishable under section 138 and 142 of the N.I. Act.
3. Court fee be returned as per rule.
