In view of directions given by the Hon'ble District Court, Yavtmal circular Outward No.2066/2026 dated 21.04.2026, special drive has been under taken during this period from date 04.05.2026 to 08.05.2026. There are defunct petty matters pending in the court and directions are given to dispose these matters during this period by restoring to provisions under section 256 and 258 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 / under section 279 and 281 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023. In the backdrop of these directions, I find this particular case fit for being dealt in this special drive.

2. Case is pending since 2020. Warrant issued against the accused. Efforts have been made to secure presence of the accused. However, the accused is not traceable since long. Thus, in such miserable situation, I find it difficult to decide the case on merit, by adopting normal procedure contemplated by the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023 for reason of failure of the prosecution to secure presence of the accused for the considerable time. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order.

ORDER

1. The proceeding is stopped vide section 281 of the Bharatiya

2. The accused is discharged for the offence punishable under Section 279 of the Indian Penal Code.
3. His bail-bond stand cancelled, if any.
