ORDER BELOW EXH.1 IN R. C. S. NO.13/2015
(Passed on 12.03.2026)

The plaintiff and defendant No. 1 to 4 are present along with their counsel. The plaintiff and defendant No. 1 to 4 have filed compromise deed at Exh.115. The plaintiff is identified by learned counsel Shri. B. G. Chaudhari, whereas defendant No.1 to 4 are identified by learned counsel Shri. Mohammad Sharique.

2. The identity cards of the plaintiff and defendant No. 1 to 4 have been filed on record i.e. aadhar cards at Exh.116 to 120 which shows that, the persons appeared before the court are the plaintiff and defendant No.1 to 4. I have read over and explained the terms and conditions mentioned in compromise deed at Exh.115 to them. They admitted contents of compromise deed at Exh.115. The plaintiff and defendant No.1 to 4 admitted signatures thereon. The court examined the plaintiff and defendant No.1 to 4 in respect of contents of compromise deed at Exh.115.

3. On perusal of record it appears that, the suit is filed for declaration, perpetual injunction and mandatory injunction. The suit is filed against defendant No.1 to 5. Defendant No.5 is Nagar Parishad Ner. Suit summons served to defendant No.5. But, defendant No.5 not appeared. Hence, my learned predecessor has passed order below Exh.1 on 15.06.2015 and matter proceeded ex-parte against defendant No.5.

4. Considering the nature of the proceeding, the contents of compromise deed at Exh.115 and the examination of the plaintiff and defendant No.1 to 4 it appears that, the terms and conditions of compromise deed at Exh.115 is lawful and acceptable. Hence, I proceed to pass the following order.

ORDER

1. The plaintiff and defendant No. 1 to 4 are permitted to compromise the matter in terms of compromise deed at Exh.115.
2. Compromise deed at Exh.115 to form part and parcel of decree.
3. Decree be drawn up accordingly as per terms and conditions of compromise deed at Exh.115.
4. Parties to take note and do the needful.
5. The court fees be refunded to the plaintiff as per rule.
6. The suit is disposed of as compromised.
