In view of directions given by the Hon'ble District Court, Yavtmal circular Outward No.1110/2026 dated 20.02.2026, special drive has been under taken during this period from date 09.03.2026 to 13.03.2026. There are defunct petty matters pending in the court and directions are given to dispose these matters during this period by restoring to provisions under section 256 and 258 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 / under section 279 and 281 of the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, 2023.
