In the present proceeding a copy of writ returned to this Court on 06.04.2026. On perusal of record, it appears that the Hon'ble High Court passed an order in Criminal Application No.1086/2024 and quashed and set aside the present proceeding bearing R.C.C. No.124/2025 arising out of Crime No.348/2024 for the offences punishable under section 498-A and 504 of the Indian Penal Code.
