ORDER BELOW Exh.1

1. *Perused the record. This is suit is instituted for the relief of partition and separate possession and application for temporary injunction therein. On perusal of record it appears that the defendant no.1 to 7 and 18 and 19 are duly served with the suit summons vide report on summons at Exh. 22, 24,36, 37, 26, 28, 39, 57 and 55 respectively. So also, the show cause notice on application for temporary injunction is also served vide report at Exh. 23,25,37, 38, 27, 29, 40, 58 and 56 respectively. The defendant no.18 and 19 also served with the summons by registered post at Exh. 54 and 53 respectively. The said defendants are absent when called till 4.00 p.m. Hence, the matter to proceed exparte against defendant no.1 to 7 and 18 and 19.*

2. *It appears that the deft.no.24 appeared before Court in response to the suit summons and show cause notice for application of temporary injunction. She has filed an application for time to file W.S at Exh.13. But, she failed to file her W.S and reply. Today she is absent when called. No application for adjournment is moved on her behalf. Hence, the suit to proceed without her written statement and reply to application for temporary injunction.*
