ORDER BELOW EXH. 49

1. The present application is filed by applicant for directing non applicant to file his latest three months salary slips. It is their contention that for the proper adjudication of the case, latest salary slips are necessary. Hence the present application.

2. Non applicant has filed his say at exh. 50 by opposing the application. It is his contention that, it is public document, therefore, it is not binding on him to produce it. He has already produced his salary slip of relevant time when present application is filed. Therefore, there is no need to file latest salary slip. He further contended that, it is duty of the applicant to prove the same. Hence, prayed to reject the application.

3. I have heard both sides. They have argued as per their contentions. Therefore, to avoid repetition, they are not taken here. I have perused the case and documents on record. The salary slip is public document and can be available by applying for it. So also, it is duty of applicant to prove the income of the non applicant. She can not ask non applicant to prove the same for her benefit. It is her liability to produce it to prove her case. She must stand on her own foot. As stated by non applicant, salary slip is a public document, therefore, it is necessary to applicant to file it on record. What inference can be drawn will be seen at the stage of final hearing. Hence the following order-

ORDER

- 1) The application is rejected.
