ORDER BELOW EXH.01
(Passed on 25/03/2026)

01] This is an application filed for grant of Succession Certificate under Section 372 of Indian Succession Act, 1925.

02] The applicants contended that, father of applicant No.1 to 5, father-in-law of applicant No.6 and grandfather of applicant No.7 namely Baliram Kashinath Parshive was permanent resident of Wani, Tq.Wani, Dist. Yavatmal. Deceased Baliram Kashinath Parshive is died on 10/01/2010 at Wani, Tq.Wani, Dist.Yavatmal. The wife of deceased Baliram Kashinath Parshive namely Vatsala Parshive is died on 09/09/2007 and son of deceased Baliram Kashinath Parshive namely Surendra Parshive is died on 19/11/2016.

03] Deceased Baliram Kashinath Parshive maintained Saving Account No.SB/GN/19802 at Bank of Maharashtra, Branch-Wani. An amount of Rs.4,51,000/- is lying in the said account. The non-applicant directed the applicants to bring Succession Certificate issued by the competent Court to withdraw the said amount along with interest. No one except the applicants are legal heirs of the deceased Baliram Kashinath Parshive. The applicants are the only legal heirs of deceased Baliram Kashinath Parshive. The applicants are entitled to receive the amount of Savings Account of deceased Baliram Kashinath Parshive. Lastly, they prayed to grant Succession Certificate in their name.

04] The non-applicant failed to appear before the Court in spite of service of notice. Hence, the application is proceeded ex-parte against the non-applicant.

05] Heard, the Ld. Advocate for the applicants. He submitted as per the contention of the application. The applicants filed on record evidence of applicant No.1/Sunil Baliram Parshive at Exh.14. The applicants filed Death Certificate of deceased Baliram Kashinath Parshive, Vatsala Parshive and Surendra Parshive at Exh.15 to 17, verified copies Aadhar Card of all the applicants at Exh.18 to 24 and verified copy of Bank Passbook of deceased Baliram Kashinath Parshive at Exh.25. After going through the documents placed on record, it appears that the applicants are the only legal heir of deceased Baliram Kashinath Parshive. No one except the applicants are legal heir of deceased Baliram Kashinath Parshive.

06] Moreover, the public notice was published in daily news paper "Dainik Lokdoot" dated 31/01/2026 at Exh.26. Despite of it, neither objection is received nor anybody appeared before the Court for objecting the claim of the applicants. Further, the proclamation Exh.09 was published on notice board of the Civil Court, Wani, Tahsil Officer, Wani, Municipal Corporation, Wani and on the house of deceased Baliram Kashinath Parshive and applicant No.5. However, no objection is received against claim of the applicants.

07] On perusal of evidence on record, it appears that, an amount of Rs.4,51,000/- is lying in the bank account of deceased Baliram Kashinath Parshive maintained with the non-applicant bearing

Account No.SB/GN/19802. As sated earlier, the applicants are only legal heir of deceased Baliram Kashinath Parshive. Therefore, they are entitled to get the above amount. Therefore, the succession certificate can be issued in the name of applicants as prayed for. Hence, considering above findings, I pass following order;

ORDER

1. The application is allowed.
2. Issue Succession Certificate for amount of Rs.4,51,000/- (In words Four Lakhs Fifty One Thousand Only) to claim the amount of bank account of **deceased Baliram Kashinath Parshive** in favour of the applicants on payment of requisite Court fees as per rules.
