3. Do plaintiffs prove that defendants are threatens to alienate or create third party interest in the suit property?
4. Do defendants proves that partition of suit property was effected during life time of Smt. Sakubai Parashram Dolas & plaintiffs waived their rights in other estates of deceased Parashram in lieu of Gat no.58, Survey No.80/2, Area 1.25 H.R. ?
5. Do defendants prove that plaintiffs sold the land of Gat no.58 received in their share in partition to Natthu Anandrao Kakde and received consideration ?
6. Are plaintiffs entitled for the relief of permanent injunction?
7. Are plaintiffs entitled for inquiry of mesne profit?
8. What order and decree ?
