Today the record is put up by way of a petition.

The accused person appears before the Court and files a petition praying for pleading guilty.

The record is taken up for hearing of the petition and passing necessary order.

Ld. APP is also present and raises no objection to that.

The substance of accusation for commission of offence punishable u/s 281/125(b) BNS is read over and explained to the accused in Bengali, to which the accused person has pleaded guilty by saying 'Ami Dosh Korechi'.

The accused person is once again asked as to whether he wants to plead guilty on his own to which he pleaded by saying 'Ami Dosh Korechi'.

Having taking into consideration the allegation made in the FIR and the other materials on record, I find that the interest of justice will be done if the accused person is sentenced to pay fine of Rs. 100/- for the commission of offence punishable under Section 281 of BNS and to pay fine of Rs. 400/- for the commission of offence punishable under Section 125(b) of BNS i.e. in **total Rs. 500/-** i/d to suffer S.I. for 07 days.

Hence, it is,

ORDERED

that both the accused person namely, **Tarakeswar Ram** is convicted u/s 275 BNSS for commission of an offence u/s 281/125(b) BNS.

The accused person namely **Tarakeswar Ram** is sentenced to pay fine of Rs. 100/- for the commission of offence punishable under Section 281 of BNS and to pay fine of Rs. 400/- for the commission of offence punishable under Section 125(b) of BNS i.e. in **total Rs. 500/-** i/d to suffer S.I. for 07 days..

The accused person has been admonished and cautioned in open Court.

Substantive sentence if any undergone be set-off in case fine being unpaid.
