ORDER BELOW EXH.1

(Passed on 02.04.2026)

The present application is for grant of legal heir certificate U/sec. 2 of the Bombay Regulation Act, 1827. The applicants are claiming legal heirs Certificate as being only legal heirs of deceased Lakhama Bhuru Atram who died on 11.05.2010 at Matharjun, Tal. Zari-jamni, Distt. Yavatmal.

02. It is submitted by the applicants that the applicant No. 1 is the son and applicant No. 2 is the daughter of deceased Lakhama Bhuru Atram. Upon death of deceased Lakhama Bhuru Atram, the applicants being daughter & son are the class-I heirs of the deceased. The applicants are in need of legal heirs certificate for Government work purpose. Accordingly, the applicants moved the instant application and prayed that as they are only legal heirs of deceased Lakhama Bhuru Atram, they are entitled to get legal heirs certificate.

03. A public notice was issued and published in Daily News Paper i.e. "Namo Maharashtra" on 06.02.2026 vide Exh. 14 and called upon the objection within 30 days from the general public to

the claim of the applicants for grant of legal heirs certificate. However, nobody turned up before the Court to file any objection.

04. Heard the learned advocate Shri. A. B. Kinake for applicants. Following are points for determination along with my findings and the reasons thereon as under-

REASONS

POINT NO. 1 & 2:

05. It is cleared from death certificate of the deceased Lakhama Bhuru Atram at Exh-10 and deposition of applicant No. 1 (Ex.9) that deceased Lakhama Bhuru Atram, is died due to illness at Matharjun, Distt. Yavatmal that the applicants are only legal heirs of the deceased. So also it is cleared from the death certificate of the deceased that the ordinary & permanent residence of deceased at Matharjun., Tal. Zari-Jamni, Dist. Yavatmal, which is within the jurisdiction of this Court.

06. It is evident from the testimony of the applicant No. 1 at Exh. 9 and death certificate at Exh-10, that the applicants are the only legal heirs of the deceased. Moreover, the paper publication was published vide Exh.14, however, except the applicants nobody came forward and claimed as legal heirs of the deceased person. Thus, the claim of the applicants for legal heir certificate has remained unchallenged. Considering the last and permanent

address of deceased Lakhama Bhuru Atram at Matharjun., I do not find legal impediment of jurisdiction in granting the legal heirs certificate in favour of the applicants as they prayed for. Therefore, I am inclined to answer point No.1 in the affirmative and in answer to point No. 2 I pass following order;

ORDER

1. The Application is allowed.
2. Issue legal heir certificate (being legal heir of deceased Lakhama Bhuru Atram) in favour of the applicants No. 1 & 2 as mentioned in the application on payment of sufficient Court fee as per rules.
