ORDER:

Heard on the bail application filed under Section 437 Cr.P.C. on behalf of accused Sayyora and Aziza through counsel on the ground that the accused/applicants have not committed any offence as alleged in the FIR. Nothing has been recovered from the accused. The applicants were arrested on 29.03.2024. The trial will take time and hence, no useful purpose shall be served by detaining the accused in judicial custody. As such, bail application may be allowed.

2. FIR No.32 dated 06.01.2024 U/Ss.420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC, 3 and 4 of Immoral Traffic Act, P.S. Sarabha Nagar, Ludhiana, was registered against the accused/applicants and their accomplices on the allegations that they used to keep and supply the ladies for physical relation in different hotels to different persons after obtaining huge amount from them and they used to keep the papers of those persons for misusing the same.

3. Learned counsel for accused/applicants submits that the accused/applicants have not committed any offence as alleged in the FIR. Nothing has been recovered from the accused. The applicants were arrested on 29.03.2024. The trial will take time and hence, no useful purpose shall be served by detaining the accused in judicial custody. As such, bail application may be allowed.

4. On the other hand, learned APP for the State opposed the contentions raised by the counsel for accused/applicants and, therefore, has prayed for dismissal of the bail application.

5. After hearing learned APP for the State, learned defence counsel and after going through the FIR, it comes out that the allegations levelled against the accused are that they used to keep and supply the ladies for physical relation in different hotels to different persons after obtaining huge amount from them and they used to keep the papers of

those persons for misusing the same. The Investigating Officer ASI Sukhdeep Singh has produced the record and suffered statement that except the bail application pending before this court, accused has not filed any other bail application before any learned Superior Court and except the present case, no other case is pending against accused/applicants. I am of the view that there are serious allegations against the accused. The FIR is registered under Sections 465, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC. As such I do not find any plausible ground to admit the accused to bail. As such, bail application filed on behalf of the accused Sayyora and Aziza is dismissed. Police record be returned and bail application file be tagged with the remand papers.
