Learned APO present. Accused Kailash along with his learned counsel present.

The statement of accused has been recorded as per the provisions of Sec 313 of Cr PC. The accused denied the evidence furnished against them and wish not to produce any defence evidence.

Accused has been instructed to furnish bail and bond of amount 10,000/- as per the provisions of section 437-A of CrPC. As per the order, the said bail and bond were furnished, which were verified by the court after due examination.


Final arguments were heard. Judgment has been dictated and typed separately and following order has been passed :

31. In view of the aforesaid discussion, this Court is of the considered opinion that the prosecution has failed to prove its case beyond all reasonable shadow of doubts and the benefit of doubt ought to be granted to accused, who is entitled to be exonerated of the charge against him in the present case.

Accordingly, accused Kailash is hereby found **not guilty** of the offence punishable under Section 379 IPC, and is hereby **acquitted** of the offence punishable under Section 379 IPC.

Accused Kailash is, hereby found **not guilty** of the offence punishable under Section 4/21 of MMDR Act, and is hereby **acquitted** of the offence punishable under Section 4/21 of MMDR Act.

No subsequent proceeding remains in this file. The file is hereby disposed off. Concerning Criminal clerk is instructed to deposit the file to the records as per rules.
