ORDER ON QUANTUM OF SENTENCE

Arguments heard on the point of quantum of sentence. Learned APP submitted that the convicts be sentenced with maximum punishment provided for the offence in the statute. On the other hand, convicts have prayed for a lenient view. They have submitted that they are poor persons and first time offenders. They further submitted that lenient view be taken and they be released on probation. Separate application for releasing accused on probation filed. Separate affidavits have been filed by all convicts that they have not been convicted in any other case in past.

2. After hearing convicts and learned APP for the State and after taking into consideration the facts and circumstances of the case, age, character and antecedents of the convicts, I am of the opinion that instead of sentencing the convicts to any punishment at once, they should be given a chance to reform themselves and it would be in the interest of justice and also in the interest of both the parties that benefit of probation be extended to the convicts.

3. A summary enquiry was conducted qua financial status of accused in order to fix victim compensation in view of law laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in **Ankush Shivaji Gaikwad versus State of Maharashtra 2013(2) RCR (Criminal) SC 1036**.

4. Convicts are hereby ordered to be released on probation of good conduct under section 4(1) of the Probation of Offenders Act, on furnishing probationary bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- each with one

surety each in the like amount, for a period of one year i.e from 16.07.2026 to 15.07.2027 and to maintain peace and good conduct in the society during this period and to come and receive the punishment as and when called by the court during the probation period. Convicts are further directed to pay cost of ₹1,000/- each as per Section 5(1) (b) of The Probation of Offenders Act, 1958.

5. Total cost of ₹3,000/- paid. Receipt given. Papers be separately registered under proper head. Requisite bonds furnished, accepted and attested. File be consigned to the record room after due compliance.
