

Crl.misc.8244/2026

Case called out.

Petitioner counsel present.

I heard on side of counsel for petitioner.

The petitioner has filed this petition U/s.438 of Cr.P.C praying to grant him anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest in Crime No. 213/2017 of Siddapura Police station pending on the file of II ACJM, Bengaluru for the offences U/s.420, 467, 323, 468, 324 of IPC.

The petitioner has filed the application U/s.438(1) of Cr.P.C praying him to grant interim anticipatory bail in the event of his arrest by the Siddapura Police.

The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the investigating officer after investigation has filed 'B' Report. But, thereafter the complainant has filed the objection to the 'B' report and the learned II ACJM, Benglauru as per order dt: 18.01.2022 rejected the 'B' report and referred the case again for further investigation. Now the respondent police trying to arrest the petitioner who is Senior Citizen who is aged 74 years. He submitted that the petitioner is Ex Additional Labour Commissioner and merely because the amount disbursed on the basis of the order of Labour Commissioner where settlement

taken place, the petitioner can not be made liable. He submitted that the complainant himself received the cheque amount on 30.11.2012. The complainant after lapse of 5 years filed false complaint.

I perused the copy of 'B' report, copy of FIR, order passed by learned Magistrate, copy of deposition, copy of Aadhar card of the petitioner. The petitioner is Senior citizen, he is Ex Additional Labour Commissioner. At this stage, there is sufficient grounds made out to grant interim anticipatory bail till next date. Hence, I proceed to pass the following:-

ORDER

Interim anticipatory bail is granted to the petitioner / accused No.1 till next date. In the event of the arrest of petitioner by respondent police the petitioner shall be released on bail on his executing personal bond for Rs.1,00,000/- with one surety for like sum.

The petitioner shall not tamper with the prosecution witnesses.

The petitioner shall co-operate the I.O for investigation.

The petitioner shall not commit similar offences.

Issue notice to PP.
