

Sukha VS STATE OF PUNJAB

ORDER

1. ASI Didar Singh appeared and suffered statement that applicant-accused Sukha has joined the investigation in FIR no.163 of 2023 and surrendered his passport as per directions of this court. He is no more required for further investigation.

2. Since the presence of the accused/applicant has already been procured, therefore, without commenting on the merits of the case, the interim bail granted to the accused-applicant vide order dated 11.08.2023 is hereby confirmed/ absolute subject to the following conditions:-

1. that the applicant shall not leave the country without the prior permission of the Illaqa Magistrate till presentation of challan and thereafter without the permission of the trial Court;
2. that the applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
3. that the applicant shall continue to cooperate with the investigating agency;
4. that the applicant shall regularly attend the hearings before the trial Court;

3. However, if the applicant became absent without intimation or misuses the concession of bail, the concerned Court will be at liberty to cancel the bail order. Any observation made herein above shall have no bearing on the merits of the case. Police record be returned. This file be consigned to the record room.
