COMMITMENT ORDER:

The above named accused have been sent up to face trial by the Station House Officer of Police Station Model Town, Panipat for commission of offence punishable under sections **109(1), 308(4), 111(2)(b), 61 and 3(5) of The Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 (hereinafter referred to as BNS) and sections 25, 27 & 29 of Arms Act in FIR No.19 dated 24.01.2026.**

2- Brief facts of the case of prosecution are that on 24.01.2026, between 4:00 to 4:30 PM, the cousin of the complainant namely Subramanyam aged 38 years was present in his office. At that time, three men on motorcycle, one on another motorcycle and two on foot reached the office and called Subramanyam outside the office. They took him to another side to talk and suddenly shot him on his forehead and abdomen three times. They also fired other shots also at that time. Thereafter, he was taken to the hospital. The said complaint was also read over the victim and accepted to be corrected. With these allegations, complainant prayed for taking legal action.

3- On this information, a formal FIR was registered for the commission of offence punishable under sections 109 & 3(5) of BNS and section 25 of Arms Act.

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Investigation was set into motion. Accused persons were arrested in the present case. During investigation, on the basis of disclosure statements of accused persons, sections 308(4), 111(2)(b), 61 of BNS, 2023 and sections 27 & 29 of Arms Act were added. On completion of investigation, final report u/s 193 BNSS, 2023 was prepared and filed in the Court by the SHO, P.S Model Town, Panipat.

4- Copy of the challan was supplied to accused free of cost as envisaged under Section 231 of BNSS, 2023.

5- I have heard the learned Assistant Public Prosecutor for the State and learned counsel for the accused and have gone through the case file very carefully.

6- Perusal of the challan shows that accused present before this Court has been charge-sheeted by IO and SHO concerned for the alleged commission of offence under 109(1), 308(4), 111(2)(b), 61, 3(5) of BNS, 2023 and sections 25, 27 & 29 of Arms Act, however, Section **109(1) of BNS**, is exclusively triable by the Ld. Court of Sessions. Therefore, the case is now committed to the Ld. Court of Sessions, Panipat for trial for **29.05.2026**. Accused who are in custody, are remanded to judicial custody during and till the conclusion of trial before Ld. Sessions Court under Section 232(b) of the BNSS, 2023 subject to law of bail etc. Accused be produced before Ld. Sessions Court through V.C. at 10:00 A.M. sharp.

7- Reader of this Court is directed to prepare requisite Calandra of this case and the Ahlmad concerned of this Court is directed to complete the case file in all respects and send the same to the Ld. Court of Sessions, Panipat, along with record of

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the case and the documents and articles if any, which are to be produced in evidence.

Factum of commitment of the case is notified to the State through the Learned Assistant

Public Prosecutor present in the court.
