Perusal of judicial file reveals that this is an old case and undersigned is bound to decide this case expeditiously as it is the fundamental right of the accused of speedy trial. Several opportunities were given to the prosecution to conclude the entire evidence of the prosecution. As per the well settled law in citation "Nagiana Sharma Vs. State of Bihar 1991 Criminal Law General 1195 Patna DB, the prosecution is first to make attempts to produce its witnesses namely IO, Doctor or any other documentary witness. In case of failure in their appearance on the basis of the summons issued on the request of the prosecution, the prosecution agency is to apply to the court to adopt other coercive measures as provided under the law. Moreover, as per Section 242(2) Code of Criminal Procedure the Magistrate may summon the prosecution witnesses on the application/written request filed by the prosecution, because it is always the duty of the prosecution to produce its witnesses and court can help to the extent that court can issue summons to PW's that too on the written request of the prosecution. The power to issue summons may be exercised by the court even suo moto, but is not imperative for the court to do so. If the prosecution has been negligent or guilty of laches, the court may refuse to exercise that power. This above stated fact has also been held by the double benches of Hon'ble Patna High Court and of Hon'ble Mysore High Court in the following citations; 1. State Vs. Mangi Lal Ram 1974 Criminal Law General 221 (Patna-DB). 2. State Vs. Mysore Kalulla Ahmed AIR 1971

Mysore 60 (DB). The Hon'ble Patna High Court in case titled as “Bihar State Small Scale Industries Vs. State of Bihar 1991 (2) Crimes 304 Patna has also held that “If despite of issuance of compulsive process thereed prosecution, on account of pronounced negligent, fails to execute process and does not produce the witnesses over a prolonged period of time, then the court would be entitled to acquit the accused for the want of evidence. In an another case the Hon'ble Rajasthan High Court in case titled as “Partap Singh Vs. State of Rajasthan 1982 (2) Crimes 766 (Rajasthan)” it has been held that in State cases it is the duty of the IO to produce the witnesses in the court and the IO can have summons of the witnesses from the court for their assistance. It is also held that it is the duty of the IO to get the service effected on witnesses and produced them in the court.

After taking into consideration all the citations titled above, this court is of the considered view that IO of this case has not bothered to obtain the summons of the prosecution witnesses ever and has also not bothered to get the summons of prosecution witnesses effected and to produce the witnesses in the court for their examination. But in the interest of justice, so that no prejudice may be caused to the complainant party one more opportunity has been granted to the prosecution to conclude the entire evidence on their own responsibility and after following the above discussed directions of this court and again a set of summons be also sent to the remaining witnesses.

Let remaining PWS be again summoned for 11.08.2026 through Commissionerate Ludhiana and it will be the last opportunity. A set of summons of the remaining prosecution witnesses having endorsement of last opportunity with red ink be also handed over personally to the Ld APP for the State for their service through their own office. Separate DA letter in this regard be also issued.

fixed. Perusal of judicial file reveals that this is an old case and undersigned is
bound to decide this case expeditiously as it is the fundamental right of the
accused of speedy trial. Several opportunities were given to the prosecution to
conclude the entire evidence of the prosecution. As per the well settled law in
citation "Nagiana Sharma Vs. State of Bihar 1991 Criminal Law General 1195
Patna DB, the prosecution is first to make attempts to produce its witnesses
namely IO, Doctor or any other documentary witness. In case of failure in their
appearance on the basis of the summons issued on the request of the
prosecution, the prosecution agency is to apply to the court to adopt other
coercive measures as provided under the law. Moreover, as per Section 242(2)
Code of Criminal Procedure the Magistrate may summon the prosecution
witnesses on the application/written request filed by the prosecution, because it
is always the duty of the prosecution to produce its witnesses and court can help
to the extent that court can issue summons to PW's that too on the written
request of the prosecution. The power to issue summons may be exercised by
the court even suo moto, but is not imperative for the court to do so. If the
prosecution has been negligent or guilty of laches, the court may refused to
exercise that power. This above stated fact has also been held by the double
benches of Hon'ble Patna High Court and of Hon'ble Mysore High Court in the

following citations; 1. State Vs. Mangi Lal Ram 1974 Criminal Law General 221 (Patna-DB). 2. State Vs. Mysore Kalulla Ahmed AIR 1971 Mysore 60 (DB). The Hon'ble Patna High Court in case titled as "Bihar State Small Scale Industries Vs. State of Bihar 1991 (2) Crimes 304 Patna has also held that "If despite of issuance of compulsive process the prosecution, on account of pronounced negligent, fails to execute process and does not produce the witnesses over a prolonged period of time, then the court would be entitled to acquit the accused for the want of evidence. In an another case the Hon'ble Rajasthan High Court in case titled as "Partap Singh Vs. State of Rajasthan 1982 (2) Crimes 766 (Rajasthan)" it has been held that in State cases it is the duty of the IO to produce the witnesses in the court and the IO can have summons of the witnesses from the court for their assistance. It is also held that it is the duty of the IO to get the service effected on witnesses and produced them in the court.

After taking into consideration all the citations titled above, this court is of the considered view that IO of this case has not bothered to obtain the summons of the prosecution witnesses ever and has also not bothered to get the summons of prosecution witnesses effected and to produce the witnesses in the court for their examination. But in the interest of justice, so that red ink no prejudice may be caused to the complainant party one more opportunity has been granted to the prosecution to conclude the entire evidence on their own responsibility and after following the above discussed directions of this court and again a set of summons be also sent to the remaining witnesses.

Let remaining P red ink WS be again summoned for 20.08.2026 through Commissionerate Ludhiana and it will be the last opportunity. A set of summons of the remaining prosecution witnesses having endorsement of last opportunity with red ink be also handed over personally to the Ld APP for the State for their service through their own office. Separate DA letter in this regard be also issued.
