## **COMMON JUDGEMENT**

1. The present applications have been filed by applicants who are persons who owned agricultural land situated in Village Kavitha (Taluka Bavla) with villages Kariyana, Kesargadh, Jalalpurgodhaneshwar, Lana, Sarandhi, Vasna Chacharvadi, Juval Rupawati, Chaloda, Rupgadh, Bhat, Vejalka, Bholad, etc. (Taluka Dholka), District Ahmedabad, and some portion of which land has been acquired by the Central Government under provisions of the Highways Act for construction of national highway under provisions of the National Highways Act, 1956. Challenge in all these applications is to the self-same award made by the District Collector, Ahmedabad, who has been appointed as an Arbitrator by the Central Government, for the purpose of determining the compensation payable for acquisition of land. The common grievance voiced in these applications is that the market value assessed by the learned Arbitrator is less and the prayer is for granting enhanced amount of compensation for the acquired land. Respondent is the Competent Authority appointed by the Central Government, the District Collector, Ahmedabad who has been appointed by the Central Government to act as Arbitrator for determination of compensation payable for land acquired under provisions of the Highways Act and NHAI authority constituted under the National Highways Authority of India Act, 1988, and delegated with the development, maintenance, and management of national highways across the country as are entrusted to it by the Central Government. The brief facts are that,

Ahmedabad - Dholera Expressway (National Highway 7.51), a greenfield highway being constructed by the National Highways Authority of India, upon this national highway being entrusted to it by the Cen Government. A stretch of the expressway passes through Villages as above, in District Ahmedabad. The lands falling in the alignment of the highway, as it passes from Villages, came to be acquired by the Central Government under provisions of the National Highways Act, 1956. There is no challenge to the acquisition of land. The Competent Authority appointed under the Highways Act is entrusted with the task of initial determination of the total amount of compensation payable for the acquisition of the land. The Competent Authority, after hearing the parties and taking into consideration the material produced by them, assessed the market value of the acquired agricultural land at Rs. 205/-, 209/- and 234/- per square meter depending upon the location of the land and determined the compensation for trees and other losses that may be incurred by the persons whose lands came to be acquired by his order dated 1.09.2019. The compensation determined by the Competent Authority came to be deposited by the National Highways Authority of India for and on behalf of the Central Government and the said amount has been disbursed to the persons entitled to receive the same as per law. As per Sub-section (5) of Section 3-G of the Highways Act provides that if any person is not satisfied with the amount of compensation determined by the Competent Authority, then such party may apply for judicious determination of compensation by an arbitrator to be appointed by the Central Government.

Applicants did not find the market value of the agricultural land and the total amount of compensation determined by the Competent Authority to be satisfactory. They, accordingly, made an application for a fresh determination of compensation before the arbitrator, and the same came to be registered as Arbitration Case. The arbitrator made a common arbitral award. The arbitrator, on a request by the land losers (private respondents herein) picked the jantri rate which was the highest for any parcel of land in the entire villages and uniformly applied the said highest rate of jantri to all the acquired lands ignoring their individual jantri rate or their locational position in comparison to the land having the highest notified jantri rate and thereafter added a 5% year-on-year increase to such highest jantri rate for the purpose of determining the total amount of compensation payable for all the acquired lands in Villages.

2. Heard learned Advocate for the applicants in each of these applications, Mr. Maulik Nanavati with Ms. Manvi Damle, learned Advocates for the National Highways Authority of India and Mr. P M Trivedi, the learned Government Pleader for the Competent Authority.

3. Learned Advocates have advanced arguments and have submitted that the same arguments may be considered as submissions in all the other applications. Accordingly, as all the applications involve similar legal issues they are being decided by this common judgment. The Ld Advocate Mr. P C Shah has argued that, regarding the acquisition of disputed land owned by us, under the National Highways Act, 1956 (hereinafter referred to as the "Act of 1956") for short. 3G (3) vide public notice bearing no. 3 issued by us under sub-section 5 of the said Act before suit No.2. Our objections filed within the time limit which are filed by us along with the list of documentary evidence have been submitted. In the present case the amount of compensation has been illegally and artificially fixed unilaterally by the arbitrator in flagrant violation of all the provisions of law which were compulsorily to be followed. Without giving any opportunity to the petitioners to be heard, arbitrator fixed the compensation of the lands arbitrarily acquired, at which time the legal provisions were not taken into consideration and without taking into account the market value of the land, loss to the farmer etc. No mandatory procedure was followed. The act of NHAI remains illegal, because as per the provisions of the said Act, after the award of payment of additional compensation by opponent No.1, the additional difference amount was to be paid to the petitioners without any delay, but in the present case, opponent No.3 has not paid such difference amount till date and So, it is urged to pay the difference amount to the applicants immediately after passing the appropriate order. The market value of the buildings constructed on the land should have been determined by a competent engineer or a person having similar skills and the assessment of the compensation for the loss of trees etc. grown on the land should have been done by a competent experienced person and the

assessment of the loss of standing crops on the land also had to be done by a competent experienced person. Also as per provisions, an amount equal to 100% of the land compensation amount determined by the authority after following all procedures of law, but, no such procedure was followed in the present case as "compensation of damages" was to be imposed. An amount equal to 50% of the compensation amount as fixed u/s 27 was to be paid to the affected families as resettlement and rehabilitation expenses such that no amount was admissible to the petitioners in the present case. Thus, the petitioners not being satisfied with the decision, are compelled to appear. That the case was proceeded before the parties and after considering the submissions of the parties and the documentary evidence, the claim of the petitioners was partially accepted. Being aggrieved by the aforesaid impugned award, we petitioners filed present petition under the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 (hereinafter referred to as "the Act of 1996") U/s. 34. The orders passed/decisions taken/compensation amounts fixed by the parties in this case are prima facie illegal, contrary to principles of morality and justice and contrary to record as discussed above and for judicial reasons to be presented hereinafter. The applicant relies on the case of R. S. JIWANI of the Full Bench of the Hon'ble Bombay High Court; HATHWAY CABLE & DATACOM PRIVATE LIMITED VS IRCON INTERNATIONAL LTD AND ORS (2009 LawSuit(Bom) 1621). It is argued that, it is held that, the principle of severability is applicable in a case and if the circumstances are found to be divisible into good part and bad part of the arbitration award, under sub-section 4 of Section 34, the good part was retained and the bad part was referred to the arbitrators for re-decision within a specified time frame with a view to correcting the error in accordance with the provisions of the said Act. It is held that the amount of compensation has been set low by authority and it is ordered to increase the amount of compensation partially, if it is considered as good part, some other things which have been stated in our original application and in the written argument, the market value of the land has not been properly determined (only the jantri has been taken into consideration, but it is much more than the jantri rate fixed by the government in the year 2011 Rs. 1757/sq. mtr. At a lower rate). Further as discussed above the provisions of the Act of 1956 and the Act of 2013 have been assessed as bad part of the statutory damages as per the judgment of the Hon'ble Bombay High Court and the same amount of the award to the petitioners. The petitioners pray that it is in the larger interest of justice that an order for prompt payment and thereafter order a re-determination within a fixed time frame with a view to remedying the bad part i.e. the legal defects as discussed and for that also please entertain the present application. If any award is found to be non-speaking or without findings and if in such circumstances the award is not in accordance with Act, in such circumstances the basic objective of enacting the said Act becomes futile. Applicants pray that an order to uphold the good part and re-determine the bad part for damages as per the discussion is lawful and in support of our contention applicants refer to the separate list from

the judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in M/S DYNA TECHNOLOGIES PVT LTD VS M/S CROMPTON GREAVES LTD (2019 LawSuit(SC) 2026). Applicants further submit that the judgment given by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the case of I-PAY CLEANING SERVICES PRIVATE LIMITED VS ICICI BANK LIMITED (2022 LawSuit(SC) 3) is applicable in that case. It is prayed to pass the appropriate judicial order to remove the defects found in the impugned award with the sole intention of keeping the good part of the impugned award intact and keeping in good faith all the evidence and instrumental documents that the impugned award was passed by the respondents no.1 without considering the evidence on record. Applicants further submit that, the Hon'ble Supreme Court in PROJECT DIRECTOR, NATIONAL HIGHWAYS NO. 45 E & 220, NATIONAL HIGHWAYS AUTHORITY OF INDIA VS M. HAKEEM & ANR. (2021 LawSuit(SC) 369) under the Act of 1956 the arbitrator is appointed by the Central Government which It is obvious that the Government is acting in such a way as to get the maximum benefit financially and in such a situation there is full apprehension of injustice to persons like the petitioner and so even in such a situation the Hon'ble Court has upheld that the court can interfere with the arbitration award whereas in the present case as discussed above the said award suffers from serious defects of that law and so with a view to removing such defects, intervene in the impugned award and pass an appropriate judicial order. Further, the Hon'ble Delhi High Court in AMAZING RESEARCH LABORATORIES LIMITED VS KRISHNA PHARMA (2023 LawSuit(Del) 1043), has elaborately discussed under which circumstances the award should be set aside and under which circumstances the bad part of the award i.e. the bad part should be sent back to the Arbitrator for reconsideration and therefore we humbly believe that the good part of the award should be maintained as discussed above and the bad part should be sent back to rectify the damage within the time limit. Applicants further submit that, the Hon'ble Gujarat High Court NATIONAL HIGHWAY AUTHORITY OF INDIA VS RAJENDRAKUMAR RAMESHBHAI PATEL (F.A. 44 OF 2024) order dt 01/02/2024 held that in the present cases even after a reading of the petitions filed, it was prayed to set aside the arbitrator's award and if Under such circumstances, if such an act is accepted, we the applicants and other farmers will have to suffer an immense loss which cannot be compensated in money and so please accept the present application. The applicant and other farmers like the petitioner have to suffer minimum economic and social loss before and after acquisition of the land whereas in the present case if we keep in view all the documentary evidences presented by us and the principles of law, the act of opponent is illegal and is against the provisions of law as well as the established principles so that even the present application of our petitioners deserves to be accepted. Applicants further submit that keeping in view the details of the petition and the reasons given therein as well as the documentary evidence submitted and the judgments of the Hon'ble Supreme Court and the Hon'ble High

Court as well as the legal provisions, upheld the amount of compensation admissible in the impugned award and justly ordered the immediate payment of such amount and the impugned award, kindly pass such judicial order that the present directing a certain time limit for rectifying the defects pointed out in the impugned award and such other defects as you may think fit in accordance with the provisions of law in the larger interest of justice.

4. Learned Advocate appearing for the National Highways Authority of India, Mr. Maulik Nanavati, has made the following submissions:

The common arbitral award dated 27.06.2023 made by the arbitrator in Arbitration Case Nos. 1 to 51 is patently illegal and offends each of the juristic principles under the umbrella of the concept of 'public policy' or 'fundamental policy'.

The arbitral proceedings have been conducted in a manner that conflicts with the provisions of the Arbitration Act and otherwise offends the most fundamental principles of legal jurisprudence. The arbitrator has misconducted himself by not adhering to and/or complying with the mandatory requirements prescribed in the Arbitration Act. The arbitrator has proceeded hastily to make an award. The award does not contain findings on all issues and is an unreasoned award. The conclusions recorded on a few issues are perverse and conflict with public policy. Further, the award is incomplete and complete and full adjudication has not been made about the amount of compensation payable to the claimants for the acquisition of their land.

The provision of Chapter V of the Arbitration Act contains provisions relating to the conduct of arbitral proceedings. Section 19 declares that parties are free to agree on the procedure to be followed by the arbitral tribunal in conducting the proceedings. It is a matter of record, and an undeniable fact, that no preliminary hearing was held by the arbitrator for according an opportunity to the parties for agreeing on a procedure to be followed by the arbitral tribunal in conducting its proceedings. There is no order on the record of the case recording the failure of parties to arrive at a consensual procedure to be adopted for conducting the arbitral proceedings. In the absence of agreement between the parties, it is always open for the arbitrator to devise his own procedure and conduct arbitral proceedings in a manner suitable to him. Again, there is no order on record of the case disclosing the mind of the arbitrator as regards the procedure intended to be adopted by him in conducting the arbitration proceeding. Without prejudice, it is submitted that any procedure that may be adopted by the arbitrator is required to be in conformity with the basic principles of law, In the facts of the present case, the procedure adopted by the arbitrator is completely alien to all recognized principles of law. The arbitrator has clubbed multiple causes of action in a singular proceeding. The arbitrator has permitted the parties to file a claim and reply but has not allowed the parties to lead evidence. The arbitrator has taken on record the written pleadings but has not granted sufficient opportunity to make oral submissions. The arbitrator

has taken into consideration material that was not produced by the parties and that too without informing the parties or giving parties to advance their submissions on such foreign material. The arbitrator has lastly made a common arbitral award for all the acquired lands without noticing the difference in their geographical locations and peculiarities attached to individual parcels of the acquired land. The arbitrator has clearly miscondacted himself in conducting the arbitral proceedings, thereby rendering the arbitral award manifestly illegal and bad in law.

In the case of *Dakshin Haryana Bijli Vitran Nigam Ltd. v. Navigant Technologies.(P) Ltd.*, reported in (2021) 7 SCC 657, the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has interpreted the need of signing the arbitral award and declared thus:

"26. Section 31(1) is couched in mandatory terms, and provides that an arbitral award shall be made in writing and signed by all the members of the Arbitral Tribunal. If the Arbitral Tribunal comprises of more than one arbitrator, the award is made when the arbitrators acting together finally express their decision in writing, and is authenticated by their signatures. [Malhotra's Commentary on Law of Arbitration, Wolters Kluwer, 4th Edn., Vol. 1, p. 794. An award takes legal effect only after it is signed by the arbitrators, which gives authentication. There can be no finality of the award, except after it is signed, since the signing of the award gives legal effect and validity to it. The making and delivery of the award are different stages of an arbitration proceeding. An award is made when it is authenticated by the person who makes it. The statute makes it obligatory for each of the members of the Tribunal to sign the award, to make it a valid award. The usage of the term "shall" makes it a mandatory requirement. It is not merely a ministerial act, or an empty formality which can be dispensed with."

In the present case, it is a matter of record and an indisputable fact that the arbitrator has not delivered to any party a signed copy of the arbitral award. The arbitral award is therefore faulty and has no legal effect, rendering it a nullity in the eye of law.

The arbitrator has not made the mandatory disclosure regarding lack of conflict of interest either with the parties or with the subject matter of dispute, and in any case has not communicated such disclosure in writing to the parties. The absence of such disclosure causes misconduct on the part of the arbitrator and vitiates the arbitral proceedings thereby rendering the arbitral award illegal and a nullity in the eyes of law.

The market value of land acquired under provisions of the National Highways Act, 1956 must be assessed as per Section 26 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013. Sub-section (1) of Section 26 provides that market value shall be determined on the basis of "market

value, if any, specified in the Indian Stamp Act, 1899 for the registration of sale deeds or agreements to sell, as the case may be, in the area, where the land is situated" or "the average sale price for similar type of land situated in the nearest village or nearest vicinity area" or "consented amount of compensation", whichever is the highest. In the present case, both the guiding parameters market value specified under the Stamp Act for registration of the sale deed of the area as also sale deeds of the three years, were available for determination of the fair market value of the land. The arbitrator has noticed the existence of this material on record. Yet, the arbitrator has chosen to make a departure from the defined methodology for assessing market value and adopted a rather irrational and illogical mechanism for determining the market value of the land. The arbitrator, for reasons best known to him, has taken the highest jantri value of land in the village and then used it as a benchmark for assessing the market value of all the acquired lands. There is nothing in the award giving any glimpse of the location of the land having the highest jantri value in the village, nor is there any discussion on the similarity of such land with all the lands that have been acquired under the Act. There is nothing emerging from a plain reading of the arbitral award as to why the arbitrator has decided to treat all the lands uniformly and treat their value at par with the land for which the government has fixed the highest jantri value in the village. There is also no reasoning given by the arbitrator for ignoring the defined parameters for assessing the market value of land and deviating from the manner of determination of market value as contained in the statutory provision. The arbitral award has therefore been passed either in ignorance of the provisions of the Act or in gross violation thereof, thereby rendering the arbitral award illegal and unsustainable in law. The uniform assessment of the market value of all the acquired lands of Villages irrespective of their geographical location and without considering the different jantri rates prescribed for each of them by the arbitrator is without any factual or legal basis. There is nothing in the entire award giving any indication of the material or factors on the basis of which the arbitrator has decided to treat all the acquired lands of the village to be at par and thereafter treat them as identical without reference or regard to their geographical location for the purpose of making assessment of market value.

The opponent NHAH submits that Section 31 of the Act of 1996 requires that the award shall state the reasons upon which it is based. The present arbitral award does not contain any reasons for re-determining and enhancing the amount of compensation awarded for acquired lands. Furthermore, the award does not disclose any reasonable basis for treating all the acquired lands of the village to be one singular block of land for the purpose of assessing their market value, particularly when the Competent Authority had treated each acquired parcel of land to be different and the lands have otherwise been assessed at different rates by the State Government.

In the case of *Dyna Technologies Private Limited v. Cromotion Greaves Limited*, reported in (2019) 20 SCC 1, the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has opined the necessity

of passing a reasoned arbitral award. The Court has held that the awards based on impropriety or perversity in reasoning and awards with inadequate reasoning would fall within the scope of Section 34 of the Act. The Hon'ble Court has held as follows:

"34. The mandate under Section 31(3) of the Arbitration Act is to have reasoning which is intelligible and adequate and, which can in appropriate cases be even implied by the courts from a fair reading of the award and documents referred to thereunder, if the need be. The aforesaid provision does not require an elaborate judgment to be passed by the arbitrators having regard to the speedy resolution of dispute.

35. When we consider the requirement of a reasoned order, three characteristics of a reasoned order can be fathomed. They are: proper, intelligible and adequate. If the reasonings in the order are improper, they reveal a flaw in the decision-making process. If the challenge to an award is based on impropriety or perversity in the reasoning, then it can be challenged strictly on the grounds provided under Section 34 of the Arbitration Act. If the challenge to an award is based on the ground that the same is unintelligible, the same would be equivalent of providing no reasons at all. Coming to the last aspect concerning the challenge on adequacy of reasons, the Court while exercising jurisdiction under Section 34 has to adjudicate the validity of such an award based on the degree of particularity of reasoning required having regard to the nature of issues falling for consideration..."

The opponent NHAI submits that the impugned arbitral is totally bereft of any legal reasoning on the issue of treating all the acquired lands homogenously and applying a common market value to all the acquired land irrespective of their geographical location. There is nothing emanating from a plain reading of the award suggestive of the factors that weighed with the arbitrator for considering and treating all the acquired lands at par with each other and arriving at a common market value as mentioned in the award for each of these lands. The award is thus patently illegal.

The opponent NHAI further submits that the arbitral award is not only unreasoned but also bereft of any findings. The opponent NHAI that the arbitrator has not framed specific issues for consideration and has not given separate findings for each such issue. A bare perusal of the arbitral award shows recitation or reproduction of the submissions of land owners, the Competent Authority, and the applicant and the decision. Recently, in the case of I-Pay Clearing Services Private Limited v. ICICI Bank Limited, reported in (2022) 3 SCC 121, the Hon'ble Supreme Court has held as follows;

"41. Under the guise of additional reasons and filling up the gaps in the reasoning, no award can be remitted to the arbitrator, where there are no findings on the contentious issues in the award. If there are no findings on the contentious issues in the award or if any findings are recorded ignoring the

material evidence on record, the same are acceptable grounds for setting aside the award itself. Under the guise of either additional reasons or filling up the gaps in the reasoning, the power conferred on the Court cannot be relegated to the arbitrator. In absence of any finding on contentious issue, no amount of reasons can cure the defect in the award.

42. A harmonious reading of Sections 31, 34(1), 34(2-A) and 34(4) of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996, make it clear that in appropriate cases, on the request made by a party, Court can give an opportunity to the arbitrator to resume the arbitral proceedings for giving reasons or to fill up the gaps in the reasoning in support of a finding, which is already rendered in the award. But at the same time, when it prima facie appears that there is a patent illegality in the award itself, by not recording a finding on a contentious issue, in such cases, Court may not accede to the request of a party for giving an opportunity to the Arbitral Tribunal to resume the arbitral proceedings." (Emphasis Added)

The opponent NHAI submits that the impugned arbitral award is incomplete in as much as it does not completely and fully adjudicate the issue about the amount of compensation liable to be paid to the claimants for acquisition of their land. The arbitrator has only assessed the market value of the acquired land. Thereafter, the arbitrator has not carried out the quantification and calculated the amount of compensation. It is settled position of law that quantification of the amount of compensation needs to be worked out by the arbitrator and that the arbitrator has no authority law to delegate such work of making arithmetical calculation to any other person or authority. The amount of compensation liable to be paid by the National Highways Authority of India, for and on behalf of the Central Government, has not been stated in the arbitral award with specificity and the arbitral award is vague, thereby rendering it illegal and bad in law.

The opponent NHAI submits that the entire case is sought to be proved on the basis of pleadings and documents appended to the pleadings. It is submitted that no evidence has been permitted to be led by parties to prove the facts asserted in the claim made by the private respondents. It is settled law that pleadings are not evidence and that a party who wants to prove anything as made out in the pleadings must give or lead evidence to provide the assertions and mere assertion of facts does not prove the said fact. The fact can only be proved by way of leading evidence, with a grant of opportunity to the other party to refute the said evidence by cross-examining the witness. In the case of *Manager, Reserve Bank of India, Bangalore v. S. Mani and Others*, reported in (2005) 5 SCC 100, the Hon'ble Supreme Court has held as follows:

"....19. Pleadings are no substitute for proof. No workman, thus, took an oath to state that they had worked for 240 days. No document in support of the said plea was produced. It is, therefore not correct to contend that the plea raised by the Respondents herein that they have worked continuously for 240 days was deemed to have been admitted by applying the doctrine of non-traverse. If any event the contention of the Respondents having been denied and disputed, it was obligatory on the part of the Respondents to add new evidence. The contents raised in the letters of the Union dated 30th May, 1988 and 11th April, 1990 containing statements to the effect that the workmen had been working continuously for 240 days might not have been replied to, but the same

is of no effect as by reason thereof, the allegations made therein cannot be said to have been proved particularly in view of the fact that the contents thereof were not proved by any witness. Only by reason of non-response to such letters, the contents thereof would not stand admitted. The Evidence Act does not say so..." (emphasis added)

The opponent NHAI submits that it is true that strict rules of evidence do apply to the arbitral proceedings, but the said exception would not permit the learned arbitrator to follow a procedure completely alien to legal jurisprudence. No arbitral tribunal can ignore the basic or fundamental principles of law. In the present case, there is no order of the learned arbitrator declaring the intention of the parties to treat the pleadings as evidence; in fact, such an order would be contrary to law. The applicant submits that the learned arbitrator has grossly erred in determining the case on the basis of such pleadings. The learned Arbitrator has committed a fundamental error of law by relying upon the unproved pleadings and adjudicating the dispute and awarding the claim only on the basis of mere pleadings. The opponent submits that the Arbitration award is otherwise erroneous in law. Learned Advocate for NHAI has further submitted that, in the present case, it is a matter of record and an indisputable fact that the arbitrator has not delivered to any party a signed copy of the arbitral award. The arbitral award is therefore faulty and has no legal effect, rendering it a nullity in the eye of law. The arbitrator has not made the mandatory disclosure regarding lack of conflict of interest either with the parties or with the subject matter of dispute, and in any case has not communicated such disclosure in writing to the parties. The absence of such disclosure causes misconduct on the part of the arbitrator and vitiates the arbitral proceedings thereby rendering the arbitral award illegal and a nullity in the eyes of law. The market value of land acquired under provisions of the National Highways Act, 1956 must be assessed as per Section 26 of the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013. Sub-section (1) of Section 26 provides that market value shall be determined on the basis of "market value, if any, specified in the Indian Stamp Act, 1899 for the registration of sale deeds or agreements to sell, as the case may be, in the area, where the land is situated" or "the average sale price for similar type of land situated in the nearest village or nearest vicinity area" or "consented amount of compensation", whichever is the highest. In the present case, both the guiding parameters market value specified under the Stamp Act for registration of the sale deed of the area as also sale deeds of the three years, were available for determination of the fair market value of the land. The arbitrator has noticed the existence of this material on record. Yet, the arbitrator has chosen to make a departure from the defined methodology for assessing market value and adopted a rather irrational and illogical mechanism for determining the market value of the land. The arbitrator, for reasons best known to him, has taken the highest jantri value of land in the village and then used it as a benchmark for assessing the market value of all the acquired lands. There is nothing in the award giving any glimpse of the location of the land having the highest jantri value in the village, nor is there any discussion on the similarity of such land with all the lands that have been acquired under the Act. There is nothing emerging from a plain reading of the arbitral award as to why the arbitrator has decided to treat all the lands uniformly and treat their value at par with the land for

which the government has fixed the highest jantri value in the village. There is also no reasoning given by the arbitrator for ignoring the defined parameters for assessing the market value of land and deviating from the manner of determination of market value as contained in the statutory provision. The arbitral award has therefore been passed either in ignorance of the provisions of the Act or in gross violation thereof, thereby rendering the arbitral award illegal and unsustainable in law. It is prayed to quash and set aside the arbitral award dated 29.06.2023 passed by the Arbitrator (District Collector, Ahmedabad) in Arbitration award, as communicated under cover of letter.

5. The following points that would arise for my consideration are:

(1) Whether petitioner has made out sufficient grounds under Section 34 of Arbitration and Conciliation Act to set aside the arbitral award?

(2) What order or award?

My findings on the above points are:

Point No.1 : In the negative

Point No.2 : As per final order

### **REASONS**

6. Heard, perused case record and documents produced by the parties. Before proceeding further this court would like to reproduce herein provision of Section 33 & 34 of Arbitration Act for the ready reference as per which necessary provisions have been made for correction and interpretation of any award before the Ld. Arbitral Tribunal under Section 33 and subsequently necessary provisions have been made regarding any application to set aside any arbitral award.

#### ***"SECTION 33 : Correction and interpretation of award; additional award.***

*1) Within thirty days from the receipt of the arbitral award, unless another period of time has been agreed upon by the parties—*

*(a) a party, with notice to the other party, may request the arbitral tribunal to correct any computation errors, any clerical or typographical errors or any other errors of a similar nature occurring in the award;*

*(b) if so agreed by the parties, a party, with notice to the other party, may request the arbitral tribunal to give an interpretation of a specific point or part of the award.*

*(2) If the arbitral tribunal considers the request made under sub-section (1) to be justified, it shall make the correction or give the interpretation within thirty days from the receipt of the request and the interpretation shall form part of the arbitral award.*

*(3) The arbitral tribunal may correct any error of the type referred to in clause (a) of sub-section (1), on its own initiative, within thirty days from the date of the arbitral award.*

*(4) Unless otherwise agreed by the parties, a party with notice to the other party, may request, within thirty days from the receipt of the arbitral award, the arbitral tribunal to make an additional arbitral award as to claims presented in the arbitral proceedings but omitted from the arbitral award.*

(5) If the arbitral tribunal considers the request made under sub-section (4) to be justified, it shall make the additional arbitral award within sixty days from the receipt of such request.

(6) The arbitral tribunal may extend, if necessary, the period of time within which it shall make a correction, give an interpretation or make an additional arbitral award under sub-section (2) or sub-section (5).

(7) Section 31 shall apply to a correction or interpretation of the arbitral award or to an additional arbitral award made under this section.

#### **SECTION 34 : Application for setting aside arbitral award**

(1) Recourse to a Court against an arbitral award may be made only by an application for setting aside such award in accordance with sub-section (2) and sub-section (3).

(2) An arbitral award may be set aside by the Court only if-

(a) the party making the application furnishes proof that-

(i) a party was under some incapacity; or

(ii) the arbitration agreement is not valid under the law to which the parties have subjected it or, failing any indication thereon, under the law for the time being in force; or

(iii) the party making the application was not given proper notice of the appointment of an arbitrator or of the arbitral proceedings or was otherwise unable to present his case; or

(iv) the arbitral award deals with a dispute not contemplated by or not falling within the terms of the submission to arbitration, or it contains decisions on matters beyond the scope of the submission to arbitration: Provided that, if the decisions on matters submitted to arbitration can be separated from those not so submitted, only that part of the arbitral award which contains decisions on matters not submitted to arbitration may be set aside; or

(v) the composition of the arbitral Tribunal or the arbitral procedure was not in accordance with the agreement of the parties, unless such agreement was in conflict with a provision of this Part from which the parties cannot derogate, or, failing such agreement, was not in accordance with this Part; or

(b) the Court finds that-

(i) the subject-matter of the dispute is not capable of settlement by arbitration under the law for the time being in force, or

(ii) the arbitral award is in conflict with the public policy of India.

*Explanation 1. For the avoidance of any doubt, it is clarified that an award is in conflict with the public policy of India, only if,*

(i) the making of the award was induced or affected by fraud or corruption or was in violation of Section 75 or Section 81; or

(ii) it is in contravention with the fundamental policy of Indian law; or (iii) it is in conflict with the most basic notions of morality or justice.

*Explanation 2. For the avoidance of doubt, the test as to whether there is a contravention with the fundamental policy of Indian law shall not entail a review on the merits of the dispute.*

*(2-A) An arbitral award arising out of arbitrations other than international commercial arbitrations, may also be set aside by the Court, if the Court finds that the award is vitiated by patent illegality appearing on the face of the award. Provided that an award shall not be set aside merely on the ground of an erroneous application of the law or by reappreciation of evidence.*

*(3) .....*

*(4).....*

*(5).....*

*(6)....."*

7. An arbitral award can be set aside only on the grounds mentioned under Section 34 and not otherwise. An arbitral award can be set aside when it is in conflict with public policy of India, which includes not in compliance with statutes and judicial precedents, passed without judicial approach, not complying with the principles of natural justice, unreasonable, affected with patent illegality, in contravention of any statute including Arbitration Act, Contract Act etc. Patent illegality in the arbitral order, howsoever must go to the roots of the matter pending before the arbitrator and the violation of public policy indisputably should be so unfair and unreasonable as to shock the conscience of the Court hearing the application to challenge the arbitral order. Matters where the arbitrator has gone contrary to or beyond the express law of contract or has granted relief in the matter not in dispute would also come within the purview of Section 34 of the Act.

8. The provisions of Section 34 of the Arbitration Act, 1996, have been discussed in detail in case of '**ONGC v. Saw Pipes**', 2003 (5) SCC 705, as per which it is held that

*" The result would be - award could be set aside if it is contrary to:*

*(a) Fundamental policy of Indian law; or*

*(b) The interest of India; or*

*(c) Justice or morality, or*

*(d) in addition, if it is patently illegal."*

*It is also further held that "Illegality must go to the root of the matter and if the illegality is of trivial nature it cannot be held that award is against the public policy. Award could also be set aside if it is so unfair and unreasonable that it shocks the conscience of the court. Such award is opposed to public policy and is required to be adjudged void."*

*It is also further held that*

*"In the result, it is held that:*

*(A) (1) The court can set aside the arbitral award under Section 34(2) of the Act if the party making the application furnishes proof that:*

*(i) a party was under some incapacity, or*

*(ii) the arbitration agreement is not valid under the law to which the parties have subjected it or, failing any indication thereon, under the law for the time being in force; or*

- (iii) the party making the application was not given proper notice of the appointment of an arbitrator or of the arbitral proceedings or was otherwise unable to present his case; or
- (iv) the arbitral award deals with a dispute not contemplated by or not falling within the terms of the submission to arbitration, or it contains decisions on matters beyond the scope of the submission to arbitration.

(2) The court may set aside the award:

- (i)(a) if the composition of the Arbitral Tribunal was not in accordance with the agreement of the parties,
- (b) failing such agreement, the composition of the Arbitral Tribunal was not in accordance with Part I of the Act.
- (ii) if the arbitral procedure was not in accordance with:
  - (a) the agreement of the parties, or
  - (b) failing such agreement, the arbitral procedure was not in accordance with Part I of the Act.

However, exception for setting aside the award on the ground of composition of Arbitral Tribunal or illegality of arbitral procedure is that the agreement should not be in conflict with the provisions of Part I of the Act from which parties cannot derogate.

(c) If the award passed by the Arbitral Tribunal is in contravention of the provisions of the Act or any other substantive law governing the parties or is against the terms of the contract.

(3) The award could be set aside if it is against the public policy of India, that is to say, if it is contrary to:

- (a) fundamental policy of Indian law; or
- (b) the interest of India; or
- (c) justice or morality; or
- (d) if it is patently illegal.
- (4) It could be challenged:
  - (a) as provided under Section 13(5); and
  - (b) Section 16(6) of the Act.

(B)(1) The impugned award requires to be set aside mainly on the grounds:

- (i) there is specific stipulation in the agreement that the time and date of delivery of the goods was of the essence of the contract;
- (ii) in case of failure to deliver the goods within the period fixed for such delivery in the schedule, ONGC was entitled to recover from the contractor liquidated damages as agreed;
- (iii) it was also explicitly understood that the agreed liquidated damages were genuine pre-estimate of damages;
- (iv) on the request of the respondent to extend the time-limit for supply of goods, ONGC informed specifically that time was extended but stipulated liquidated damages as agreed would be recovered;
- (v) liquidated damages for delay in supply of goods were to be recovered by paying authorities from the bills for payment of cost of material supplied by the contractor;
- (vi) there is nothing on record to suggest that stipulation for recovering liquidated damages was by way of penalty or that the said sum was in any way unreasonable.
- (vii) In certain contracts, it is impossible to assess the damages or prove the same. Such situation is taken care of by Sections 73 and 74 of the Contract Act and in the present case by specific terms of the contract."

9. The Hon'ble Supreme Court in the matter titled as **Swan Gold Mining Ltd Versus Hindustan Copper Ltd. Civil Appeal No. 9048 of 2014** has observed in para 12 &13 as under:-

*"12. Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act,1996 corresponds to Section 30 of the Arbitration Act,1940 making a provision for setting aside the arbitral award. In terms of sub-section (2) of section 34 of the Act, an arbitral award may be set aside only if one of the conditions specified therein is satisfied. The Arbitrator's decision is generally considered binding between the parties and therefore, the power of the court to set aside the award would be exercised only in cases where the court finds that the arbitral award is on the fact of it erroneous or patently illegal or in contravention of the provisions of the Act. It is a well settled proposition that the court shall not ordinarily substitute its interpretation for that of the Arbitrator. Similarly, when the parties have arrived at a concluded contract and acted on the basis of those terms and conditions of the contract then substituting new terms in the contract by the Arbitrator or by the court would be erroneous or illegal.*

*13. It is equally well settled that the Arbitrator appointed by the parties is the final judge of the facts. The finding of facts recorded by him cannot be interfered with on the ground that the terms of the contract were not correctly interpreted by him."*

10. It is settled legal proposition that the court is precluded from re-appreciating evidence to arrive at different conclusion by holding that arbitral award was against the public policy.
11. It is held by the Hon'ble High Court of Gujarat in the case of **Oil & Natural Gas Corporation Ltd. Vs. David Parkar Construction Ltd. C/o. I B Patel (P A Holder) & Anr.** CAV Judgment dated 12.06.2024 passed by High Court of Gujarat in First Appeal No.322 of 2010 as under:

*"11. Coming to the impugned judgment and order, we find that the learned District Judge has decided the application under Section 34 of the Arbitration Act as an Appellate Court ignoring the provisions of Section 34 of the Arbitration Act. The findings as recorded by the learned District Judge are based on re- appreciation of evidence, which is not permissible. We find that the learned District Judge has re-appreciated all the claims, counter-claims, documents and the evidence on record while allowing the application under Section 34 of the Arbitration Act.*

*12. It is now well settled that the standard of scrutiny of award can be done only on the grounds envisaged under Section 34 of the Arbitration Act. Judicial review and re-appreciation of evidence are impermissible unless it is made out that the view taken by the Arbitrator is based on patent illegality or on the interpretation of the facts and terms of the contract, which are absolutely perverse. The Court does not sit in appeal over the arbitral award and can only interfere on merits on the limited ground as provided under Section 34(2)(b)(ii), if the award is against the public policy of India, and the award should be in*

*compliance with the Statutes and judicial precedents while adopting a judicial approach and in compliance of the principles of natural justice. Further, it is well settled by the decisions of the Hon'ble Apex Court that patent illegality would constitute contravention of the substantive law of India, contravention of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and contravention of the terms of the contract. But, the interference by Courts in an arbitral award will not entail review on the merits of the dispute and has to be limited only to situations where it is found that the findings of the Arbitrator are arbitrary, perverse, shocking the conscience of the Court and where the illegality goes to the root of the matter. In the present case, we find that the view taken by the learned Arbitrator was a plausible view and in terms of the contract entered into between the parties. It is well-settled that the awards which contain reasons, when interpreting the contractual terms, are not to be interfered with lightly. Re-appreciation of evidence is not permissible. The learned Arbitrator has construed the terms of the contract in the correct perspective and hence, it was not open for the learned District Judge to interfere with the award.*

*13. Further, we find that no manifest illegality has been shown in the award before the learned District Judge nor any finding to that effect has been recorded by the learned District Judge. Further, there are apparent contradictions. In overall view of the matter, we find that the jurisdiction exercised by the learned District Judge under Section 34 of the Arbitration Act is contrary to the provisions contained therein, bad in law and hence, cannot be sustained."*

In 2018 (11) SCC 328 (Kinnari Mullick and another Vs. Ghansyham Das Damani), the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India has confirmed the proposition laid down in Bhaskar Industrial Development Lits Vs. Southern Railway, wherein it has been held that:

*"remitting the matter back to the Arbitrator would constitute an error and that the Parliament has not conferred any power of remand under Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996."*

In ILR 2010 Karnataka 3711 ( Sri. H.M. Shankaramurthy Vs. National Highways Authority of India and others) , wherein it has been held that: A.P. No.73/2020

*"... a provision for setting aside an award contending that the award is not sustainable in law on any one of the grounds as indicated above can never be construed as a provision enabling the land owner seeking for enhancement of the compensation amount as determined by the Arbitrator."*

In 2017 (4) Karnataka L.J. 27/14 (NHAI Vs. Mahadevi and others), wherein it has been held that:

*"We are satisfied that in view of the settled legal position, which is delineated below, the learned Court below has grossly erred in setting aside the arbitral award and has further compounded the said error by substituting its own valuation and compensation amount which was simply not permitted within the scope of Section 34 of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996".*

12. Arbitration is an alternative dispute resolution process which provides that parties to the dispute evolve their own dispute resolution mechanism by consenting to refer their dispute to an independent person on whom both the parties have faith and reposes trust. Autonomy, wisdom and spirit of the parties to resolve their dispute by their own mutually agreed mechanism has been put on highest pedestal by the legislation, which is the reason why legislation has provided for minimum interference of the Court in relation to Arbitration Proceeding. The provisions of Section - 34 of the Act specifically provides that except grounds stated therein the Arbitration Award cannot be challenged. The entire purpose is to give supremacy to the party autonomy.
13. Now looking to the entire case record and the written submissions made by the parties, the citations produced on record by the parties it cannot be said that the award passed by the Ld. Arbitrator is in any manner contrary to: (a) Fundamental policy of Indian law; or (b) The interest of India; or (c) Justice or morality, or (d) patently illegal. It is well settled by the decisions of the Hon'ble Apex Court that patent illegality would constitute contravention of the substantive law of India, contravention of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and contravention of the terms of the contract. The interference by Courts in an arbitral award will not entail review on the merits of the dispute and has to be limited only to situations where it is found that the findings of the Arbitrator are arbitrary, perverse, shocking the conscience of the Court and where the illegality goes to the root of the matter. the arbitral award cannot be set aside as per the provisions of and within the ambit of Section 34 of the Arbitration & Conciliation Act. In the present case, no such material has been put forward to satisfy the Court that the award is against the fundamental policy of Indian law or the interest of India or against the natural justice or morality or is patently illegal or nothing substantial to show that the award is arbitrary, perverse or shocking to the conscience of the Court. There is no material to show any patent illegality which goes to the root of the matter. Also the applicant has failed to show which part of the award is specifically a good part and which part is a bad part of the award, other than the submission that the calculation of Compensation is inappropriate and the citations relied on by the applicants are not helpful in present case. The present case being different from the produced citation, the same relied on by the applicant is not helpful in the present case. In view of the above decisions, the reliefs sought by the applicant to set aside the award and to direct the Arbitrator to re-consider the matter cannot be granted. For the above discussion, point No. 1 is answered in the negative. And point no. 2 is decided as per final order below. Therefore, the following final order is passed in the larger interest of justice:

**-:-FINAL ORDER:-**

- Present Civil Misc. Application's are hereby **dismissed**.
- No order as to costs.
- Parties to comply Arbitral award by following due process of law as early as possible.  
File be consigned to record room after due compliance.
