- [1] The present appeal has been preferred by the appellant, challenging the judgment and order dated 04.01.2025, passed by Id. 05th Addl.C.J.M., Vadodara, in Criminal Case No. 31596/2023, whereby the appellant has been convicted for the offence punishable under Section 138 of Negotiable Instruments Act and is sentenced to undergo imprisonment for six months and further ordered the appellant to pay cheque amount i.e. Rs.59,800/- towards compensation.
- [2] Pending the appeal, the parties have arrived at amicable settlement. The parties have jointly tendered a Compromise Pursis vide **Exh:7** submitting that they have arrived at settlement and also submitted to set-aside the order passed by the Id. trial Court and acquit the appellant from the offence. This pursis (**Exhs:7**) have also been counter signed by the respondent, thereby the parties have admitted the facts of the compromise arrived at between them.
- [3] Considering the fact that the parties have settled the matter amicably and a compromise pursis is produced before the Court, I pass the following order:

ORDER

- I. The present appeal is hereby allowed.
- II. The judgment and order dated 04.01.2025, passed by Id. 05th Addl.C.J.M., Vadodara, in Criminal Case No. 31596/2023, is quashed and set-aside

- III. The appellant – **Bhavesh Kailashbhai Solanki** is hereby acquitted from the charges levelled against him in this case.
- IV. Record and Proceedings if called, be sent back to Learned Trial Court along with a copy of this order.
- V. With above directions, this criminal appeal stands disposed of as compounded.
