Report from the concerned SHO regarding the LRs of Baldev Raj deceased son of Hansraj not received.

At this stage, ld. counsel for the JD- Insurance company has suffered the following statement.

“Stated that JD-Insurance Company had deposited total enhanced amount of Rs.4,90,304/-, out of which an amount of Rs.98,056/- had been disbursed to claimant No.2 - Raj Rani and Rs.2,94,182/- had been disbursed to claimant No.3 - Lovleen Kaur d/o deceased Ramesh Kumar and their share and share of deceased claimant No.1-Hans Raj i.e. remaining amount of Rs.98,066/- is still lying deposited in the account of this Tribunal. Since he has died during the pendency of appeal in the Hon’ble High Court. That LRs. of Hans Raj deceased has not come in the Court for claiming the share of Hans Raj, despite efforts made by the Court. In case the share amount of Rs.98,066/- of deceased claimant No.1 Hans Raj is returned to Insurance company without imposed any future interest then the insurance company shall deposit the said amount in the account of this Tribunal, as and when any legal heirs of claimant No.1- Han Raj put appearance before the Court.’
