Matter is at the stage of remaining cross-examination
of CW1.

Ld. Counsel for complainant has filed an application
for seeking exemption of main counsel of complainant and
complainant on the ground that main counsel of complainant is
travelling out of station. Further, prior intimation was given to the
opposite counsel around 2 days ago.

Ld. Counsel for accused strongly opposes the said
adjournment on the ground that complainant is in habitual
conduct of derailing the proceedings of the court.

In view of submissions made, adjournment is
allowed for today.

Ld. Counsel for accused submits that he has not
received the documents on which cross-examination was deferred
till date.

Complainant is directed to remain physically present
alongwith the requisite documents on the NDOH. Advance copy
be supplied to the opposite counsel prior to 7 days of NDOH, else
cost of Rs.5,000/- shall be imposed on the complainant.

19.08.2026.
