

**CBI Case No. RC-DAI-2022-A-0011
U/s 120B IPC & Sec. 7, 8 & 12 PC Act 1988
CBI Vs. Mohd. Khalid**

This bail application under Section 167 Cr.P.C for grant of default bail has been placed before the undersigned as the Link Court is stated to be on leave.

Present: Sh. Lalit Mohan, Ld. P P for CBI.

Sh. Rajiv Mohan, Ld. Counsel for the applicant/accused Khalid Moin.
Investigating Officer/Inspector Umesh Kaushik is present.

Both sides heard on the application for default bail u/s 167 Cr.P.C. moved on behalf of applicant/accused Khalid Moin.

The above referred case was registered on 16.03.2022 u/s 7, 8 and 12 of PC Act 1998, by CBI, Anti-Corruption Branch, new Delhi on the basis of source information that accused Mohd. Khalid Moin was indulging in corrupt practices and was demanding undue advantage/bribe amount which was to be paid in the afternoon of 16.03.22 by accused Prakhar Pawa to co-accused Mohd. Khalid Moin i.e the applicant herein.

Reply from Investigatinig Officer/Inspector Umesh Kaushik has been filed today.

As per the application, 60 days period from the date of arrest has already elapsed and till date charge sheet has not been filed by the IO. IO as well as Ld Prosecutor for CBI, who are present in the court have also conceded to the fact that stipulated time of 60 days for filing chargesheet from date of arrest of applicant has

already elapsed.

Even in the reply, IO has submitted that accused was arrested on 16.03.2022 and till date investigation is not complete and charge sheet has yet not been filed.

In view of the fact that 60 days time from the date of arrest has already elapsed, right to default bail under section 167 CrPC, has accrued in favour of applicant. Accordingly, applicant/accused Khalid Moin is admitted on bail on his furnishing bail bond in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with two sureties in the like amount subject to following conditions that:

- i) Accused will surrender his passport in the Court, if not already surrendered.
- ii) He shall not leave the country without prior permission of the Court.
- iii) He will not meet the witnesses of this case nor he would threaten or influence them.
- iv) He shall attend the Court as and when directed to do so.

With this, the present application stands disposed of.
