Rahul @ Roll Vs. State of Punjab

Heard on the bail application of applicant/accused Rahul @ Roll. It is submitted that the applicant/accused is innocent person and has not committed any offence. The police has registered a false case against the applicant/accused. The applicant/accused was arrested on 22.03.2026 and since then he is in judicial custody. No recovery is pending against the accused. The applicant/accused undertakes to appear in the Court on each and every date of hearing. Lastly, prayer has been made to release the accused on bail.

Notice of the application was given to the State. However, Learned APP for the State has not filed any reply but has orally opposed the same.

Statement of Head Constable Roop Singh No. 04/Jal. (Rural) recorded to the effect that no other bail application of applicant/accused Rahul @ Roll son of Mandeep Kumar is pending or decided either by the Hon'ble High Court or by Learned Sessions Court in the present case except the present bail application. There is FIR no. 62 dated 20.04.2026 u/s 27-61-85 NDPS Act at PS City Nakodar, FIR no. 73 dated 28.06.2022

u/s 379-B, 411 IPC at PS City Nakodar, FIR no. 52 dated 07.07.2023 u/s 379, 411 IPC at PS Lambra, FIR no. 56 dated 13.05.2024 u/s 379-B, 411 at PS Sadar Nakodar are also registered against said accused Rahul @ Roll, other than the present one. The said accused has not been declared proclaimed offender in this case.

Heard. Record perused.

As per the record the present FIR has been registered against the applicant/accused along with his co-accused accused under Sections 305, 331 (4) BNS. The allegations against the applicant/accused are serious in nature. The co-accused are yet to be arrested. The punishment provided for committing the offence under Section 331 (4) BNS is imprisonment upto 14 years. As per the statement of Investigating Officer, except the present FIR, four more FIRs are also pending against the accused, suggesting that the accused is a habitual offender. These kind of offences are rising day by day. In case applicant/accused is released on bail, there are chances that he may abscond and flee the course of justice. If at this stage the accused is released on bail then there are chances of committing of similar offence. There is every likelihood that the applicant/accused may tamper with prosecution evidence. As such, the present bail application moved by applicant/accused stands dismissed.
