ORDER :

Report of SHO received. Heard on the application filed by applicant Krishan Kumar for releasing the vehicle i.e. Motorcycle Hero M, HF Deluxe self, bearing registration no.PB-11CA-9532, on superdari to him.

The Ld. APP for the State opposed the application on the ground that the applicant will not produce the case property in the Court and the case of the prosecution will be prejudiced.

Police report perused. The Police Agency has reported that in view of record the abovesaid motorcycle is registered in the name of Jaswinder Singh son of Rachhpal Singh but in view of sale affidavit the said motorcycle was sold by Jaswinder Singh to Krishan Kumar son of Hukam Chand and police agency raised no objection in releasing the above said vehicle on sapurdari to the owner of the vehicle. Further the applicant has placed on record copy of RC of the vehicle in question in the name of Jaswinder Singh son of Rachhpal Singh who is the registered owner of the vehicle in question and from whom the applicant purchased the vehicle in question. The applicant also placed on record photocopy of affidavit vide which Jaswinder Singh had sold the abovesaid motorcycle to the applicant. Accordingly, the vehicle i.e. **Motorcycle Hero M, HF Deluxe self, bearing registration no.PB-11CA-9532**, is ordered to be released on sapurdari in favour of the applicant being the owner on his furnishing sapurdarinama in the sum of **Rs.40,000/-** with one surety in the like amount, subject to the following conditions.

1. The applicant shall produce the same in the court on each and every date of hearing or as and when directed by the Court.

2. The applicant shall not sell or alienate the same or change its colour, condition or modify the same without permission of the court.

The SHO concerned is directed to take photographs of the vehicle at the expense of applicant and submit the same to this Court before releasing the same on sapurdari to the applicant. Copy of this order be sent to the SHO concerned.

Requisite bonds/ sapurdari bonds not furnished.
