Ld. Additional PP appeared on behalf of
respondent waived off the service of notice. Let police
report be filed on **26.12.2022**. Till then in the event of
his arrest, the bail-applicant be admitted on pre-
arrest/interim bail in aforesaid case FIR, subject to
furnishing of personal and surety bonds in the sum of
₹50,000/- each to the satisfaction of I.O. subject to the
following conditions:

- v. That the bail applicant shall made himself available for interrogation as and when called by the investigating officer, in this case,
- vi. That the bail applicant shall not leave India without prior permission of the court,
- vii. That the bail applicant shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade her from disclosing such facts to Court or to any police officer; and
- viii. That the bail applicant shall not commit an offence similar to offence of which applicant is accused in the present case;

Be listed on the date fixed i.e. **26.12.2022**, for filing of reply/police report.
