Child in conflict Abhishek Kumar with law closed his defence
evidence by making separate statement.

Arguments heard. Vide my separate judgment of even date, the
Child in conflict with law Abhishek Kumar stands acquitted, as detailed
therein.

It has been mentioned that the proceedings qua the other co-
juvenile namely Rohit Rabat was separated under Section 317 Cr.P.C, vide
order dated 27.01.2025. It was ordered by Undersigned vide order dated
01.04.2025, that since, there was no record as to whereabouts of the CCL
Rohit Rabat and were not known by the Board or brought to the notice of
Board, so the proceedings qua the other co-jvenile namely Rohit Rabat
were ordered to be consigned to the record room and shall be revived as and
when CCL Rohit Rabat will be apprehended, produced or appears before the
Board. It was further ordered that as per Juvenile Justice (Care and
Protection) 2016 Act Rule No. 92, a separate inquiry qua missing child was
directed to be conducted by Child Welfare Officer. Thereafter, if required
FIR be registered qua the missing child Rohit Rabat. Probationary Officer
was directed to address Juvenile Police Wing for taking immediate action for
tracing the child and inquire into the facts and circumstances of dis-
appearance of child and thereafter complete report be sent to Juvenile Justice
Board, Fatehgarh Sahib.

Now, the proceedings qua the other co-jvenile namely Rohit Rabat be attached with the main file and be consigned alongwith main file to the Judicial Record Room, Fatehgarh Sahib in cover.

The proceedings qua the other co-jvenile namely Rohit Rabat shall be revived as and when CCL Rohit Rabat will be apprehended, produced or appears before the Board.
