Record is put up on the basis of petition filed by petitioner.

Ld. Advocate for the petitioner submits that the matter is amicably resolved and the petitioner does not want to contest the case. He prays for passing of necessary order for disposal of the case.

Petitioner Champa Das is present. As the record is put up the petitioner is called on dock to verify the contents of petition and Affidavit filed by her. It needs to be noted that OP is yet to appear to contest the case.

Petitioner deposed on oath that the matter is amicably resolved and that she does not want to proceed with the case. She also highlighted that compromise was done as per her own free will. She also affirmed that the petition and Affidavit filed today was prepared as per her instruction.

The instant case is filed for realization of maintenance arrears. It appears that the parties has opted for amicable settlement and that the petitioner herself does not want to contest the case. In view of the aforesaid circumstance, I am of opinion that the court should not stand in the way of parties and the case should be disposed of.

Accordingly, the case is DISMISSED ON COMPROMISE.
