This petition is coming on this day before me for hearing in the presence of M/s.Nathan and Associates, Counsel for the petitioner and upon hearing petitioner's side, this Court delivered the following,

ORDER

1. 1.The Petitioner/Accused seeks to extend the time for complying with the order dated 17.04.2026 passed in M.P.No. 1 of 2026 and pass suitable orders.

**2. This court had earlier ordered as follows:**

(1) That the Appellant/Accused shall execute a bond for Rs.10,000/- with two sureties each for the same likesum to the satisfaction of the Learned XXXVII Metropolitan Magistrate, FTC-IV, George Town, Chennai.

(2) That the Appellant/Accused shall deposit 20% of the compensation amount into the credit of S.T.C.No.1849/2022 before the trial court within a period of 60 days from the date of this order.

(3) Presently the petitioner has claimed that as per the conditions imposed by this court's order in M.P.No.1/2026 on 17.04.2026 he is directed to execute a bond for Rs.10,000/- with two sureties each for the same likesum to the satisfaction of the Learned XXXVII Metropolitan Magistrate, FTC-IV, George Town, Chennai and to deposit 20% of the compensation amount before the trial court. Due to his health condition the petitioner was not able to appear before the Metropolitan Magistrate. The petitioner is unable to travel to the court premises to fulfill the surety requirements. The petitioner was not able to arrange and produce the sureties within the stipulated time and due to the financial crisis the appellant could not deposit the 20% of compensation amount before the Trial Court within 60 days. The appellant/petitioner has presently claimed that he has initiated steps for the sale of certain immovable properties belonging to him. Negotiations in this regard are



presently in progress and are expected to be finalized shortly. Hence the petitioner prays to extend the time for complying with the conditions imposed by this Court.

(4) Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and the submission made by the petitioner's counsel, the time granted for complying with the condition to execute a bond for Rs.10,000/- with two sureties each for the same likesum to the satisfaction of the Learned Metropolitan Magistrate, Fast Track Court -IV, George Town, Chennai and also for depositing the 20% of compensation amount before the trial court is extended till 08.07.2026. The petitioner shall comply with the conditions on or before 08.07.2026.
