ORDER

These proceedings are not meant for recovery of dowry articles as held by Hon’ble High Court of Punjab and Haryana in case titled as **Esha Batra vs. State of Punjab and another, CRM-M-39942-2022, decided on 12.09.2022**. Since applicant has joined the investigation and has complied with the order dated 25.06.2025, as such

the order dated 25.06.2025 is hereby made absolute, till the presentation of challan, subject to the following terms:

- i. That the applicant shall make himself available for interrogation by the police as and when required and in case, at any stage, applicant will not co-operate in the investigation, prosecution agency will be at liberty to seek cancellation of bail;
- ii. That the applicant shall not, directly or indirectly, make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer;
- iii. That the applicant shall not leave India without the prior permission of the Court.
- iv. That the applicant will seek regular bail on the presentation of the challan in Court.

Application accordingly stands disposed of. File be returned to the concerned court.
