ORDER

Police record has been received. Arguments have been heard on regular/ interim bail of above referred applicant in the above referred case. In view of the police record and as per the statement of HC Sukhwinder Singh No.2851/BTL, P.S. Fatehgarh Churian as has been recorded today in the court that there are allegations of recovery of 227 intoxicant tablets without label without without any valid permit or

licence was effected from the accused/applicant Sohan Singh by the police party headed by ASI Palwinder Singh, P.S. Fatehgarh Churian on 14.07.2018 at about 8.05 A.M., in the area of Bus Stand Fatehgarh Churian. The accused/applicant Sohan Singh is in judicial custody since 14.07.2018 in this FIR. Till date no record is depicting of his previous involvement in such like activities. Report of chemical examiner is awaited and the challan has not been presented till date. The said allegations are warranting the offence punishable under section 21/22 of NDPS Act against him.

2. In such a situation as referred above, it has been relied upon 2014 (3) RCR (Criminal) 953 titled as Inderjeet Singh @ Laddi Versus State of Punjab, that the applicant is at least entitled to interim bail till that report is finally received. Consequently, the applicant is hereby admitted on **interim bail** subject to result of report of Chemical Analysis and subject to furnishing bail bonds in the sum of Rs.50,000/- with one surety bond of like amount with the conditions that applicant-accused will not tamper with the evidence; will attend the court on each and every date of hearing and will not leave India without prior permission of the court till the disposal of the trial. This is conditional order of interim bail, subject to the result of report of Chemical Analysis. Bail application be attached with the file of concerned FIR. Police record be returned to the concerned quarter.
