

B.A. 2129 Aman Arora vs. State of Punjab

Present: Sh.Bikram Arora, advocate, counsel for the applicant/accused
Sh. Ashok Kumar, APP for the State along with ASI Inderjit Singh.

The applicant-accused has joined the investigation. Separate statement of ASI Inderjit Singh also recorded. The accused-applicant has joined the investigation and he is not required for further interrogation, therefore, the interim order dated 14.08.2023 is made absolute subject to the following terms:-

1. That the applicant shall make himself available for interrogation by the police as and when required.
2. That the applicant shall not, directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the accusation against him so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer.
3. That the applicant shall not leave India without the prior permission of the Court.
