Ram Singh @ Rama aged about 41 years son of Dev Singh @ Baldev Singh, resident of Village Chathe Sekhwan, Tehsil and District Sangrur, presently lodged in District Jail, Sangrur.

First regular bail application under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. filed by applicant Ram Singh @ Rama.

ORDER:

This order shall dispose of an application moved under Section 439 of Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail, on behalf of applicant/accused Ram Singh @ Rama, pertaining to above noted criminal case.

2. As per prosecution case, on 22.09.2021, a police party of Police Station Longowal headed by SI Ram Singh was going from Badrukhan to village Ubhawal in connection with general checking. When they reached near Baba Sidhana Sahib, at about 10:40 p.m., they saw three young boys sitting near the trees and one of them was sitting on the seat of scooter. Upon seeing the police party, they tried to slip away, but were apprehended by the police party. Those persons disclosed their names as Jaswinder Singh

@ Jassi, Ajay @ Robin @ Gobhi and Satgur Singh @ Fauji. Jaswinder Singh @ Jassi and Ajay @ Robin @ Gobhi were found in possession of one country made 315 bore pistol alongwith its one live cartridge each. Satgur Singh @ Fauji was found in possession of three live cartridges of 315 bore country made pistol. Present case was registered against the accused and they were arrested. During interrogation, Satgur Singh @ Fauji disclosed that the pistol, which was handed over by him to Jaswinder Singh @ Jassi, was given to him by Ram Singh resident of village Chathe Sekhwan. Ram Singh was accordingly nominated as accused in this case and he was arrested on 25.06.2022. Bail application of accused Ram Singh @ Rama was dismissed by the Court of Ms.Sumit Sabharwal, Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Sangrur, vide order dated 15.07.2022. Hence, this bail application is moved by him under Section 439 of Cr.P.C.

3. Notice of this application was given to learned Public Prosecutor for State, who appeared and opposed this bail application. Police record of this case was also summoned.

4. I have heard learned counsel for applicant/accused, learned Public Prosecutor for State and have gone through the record pertaining to this case very carefully, with their able assistance.

Other co-accused of applicant-accused Ram Singh @ Rama has already been released on regular bail in this case. Ram Singh @ Rama was not named in the present FIR and he was nominated as accused in this case on the basis of disclosure statement of co-accused Satgur Singh @ Fauji. Nothing was recovered from him in this case. Present case is triable by the

Judicial Magistrate Ist Class. The allegations of the prosecution are yet to be proved against the applicant-accused. Final disposal of trial will take considerable time and no useful purpose would be served by keeping him behind the bars for an indefinite period. Applicant-accused is ready to comply with all the terms and conditions of the bail. So, keeping in view all these facts and circumstances, this bail application deserves to be allowed.

Accordingly, this bail application stands allowed and disposed of. Applicant/accused Ram Singh @ Rama is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bond in the sum of ₹50,000/- with one surety of the same amount to the satisfaction of Area/Duty Magistrate. Anything said in this order is only for the purpose of disposal of this bail application and will not affect the merits of the main trial in any manner. Police record be sent back. Record of this bail application be consigned.
