This petition coming on this day before me for hearing in the presence of Tmt.S.Dhanalakshmi, Advocate for the petitioner and the Inspector of Police, Kuvagam represented as per the order of the Superintendent of Police, Ariyalur in C.No.366/SB/X/ALR/2026, dated: 02.07.2026 appeared for state and upon hearing both sides and upon perusing the petition and other relevant records, this court delivered the following; and upon hearing both sides and upon perusing the petition and other relevant records, this Court delivered the following;

ORDER

Petition filed through E-filing U/s 430(1) of BNSS 2023 by the petitioner praying for suspension of sentence imposed by the Judicial Magistrate No.II, Jayankondam in C.C.No. 450/2017, dated 09.03.2026 and seeking bail to the petitioner.

Wherein the 1st Petitioner (A2) / Appellant/ accused was convicted for the offence U/s.148 of IPC and sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment of 3 months and U/s.294(b) r/w. 149 of IPC and sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment of 1 month and U/s. 341 r/w. 149 of IPC and sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment of 1 month and U/s.324 of IPC and sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment of 25 months and to pay a fine of Rs.4,000/- in default to undergo 1 months simple imprisonment and the 2nd Petitioner (A5) / Appellant/ accused was convicted for the offence U/s.147 of IPC and sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment of 1 month and U/s.294(b) of IPC and sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment of 1 month and U/s. 341 r/w. 149 of IPC and sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment of 1 month and U/s.324 r/w 149 of IPC and sentenced to undergo simple imprisonment of 25 months and to pay a fine of Rs.4,000/- in default to undergo 1 months simple imprisonment. The petitioners have paid the fine amount before the trial court. The petitioners/ accused are in judicial custody from 06.05.2026. Hence prayed for suspension of sentence and grant bail to the petitioner.

The learned counsel appearing for the petitioners prayed before this court to suspend the execution of sentence imposed on the petitioners till the disposal of the Criminal appeal. In this case, the trial Court has suspended the sentence till 10.04.2026, but the petitioners did not file any receipt of appeal, hence the trial court was revoked the suspension of sentence and NBW issued against the petitioners (A2 and A5) on 30.04.2026, the petitioners/ accused are in judicial custody from 06.05.2026.

This court perused the rival submissions of both side. In this case, the co-accused has been filed a criminal appeal before this court and the above said case was taken on file and numbered as CrI.Appeal No.11/2026 and the same is pending. Considering petitioners were inside the prison for the past above two months, this court is inclined to suspend the sentence of imprisonment imposed on them and ordered to be released on bail with the following conditions.

In the result, this petition is allowed and the sentence imposed on the petitioners shall be suspended on executing a bond for Rs.10,000/- along with two sureties each for the like sum to the satisfaction of the Judicial Magistrate No.II, Jayankondam. The Petitioners/Accused shall appear before the Appellate Court regularly for all the hearings without fail.
