This petition coming on this day before me for hearing in the presence of Thiru. K. Ravisankar, Advocate through appeared virtual mode for the petitioner and of Thiru.C.Chinnathambi, Public Prosecutor for the state and upon hearing both sides and upon perusing the petition and other relevant records, this court delivered the following;

ORDER

Petition filed u/s.482 of BNSS Act 2023 by the petitioner seeking extension of time to surrender the petitioner through E-filing.

The respondent police have registered a case against the petitioner in Crime No. 178/2026, U/s. 296(b), 118(1), 133, 74 of BNS Act on 03.04.2026.

The learned counsel for the petitioners contended that the petitioners was granted anticipatory bail in Cr.M.P.No. 774/2026, dated: 07.05.2026. The petitioners were directed to surrender before the Judicial Magistrate No.II,

Jayankondam on or before 22.05.2026 and the Petitioner/accused shall appear and sign before the Respondent Police Station daily at 10.00 A.M for three weeks. But at the time the petitioner's relatives admitted in hospital, hence the petitioner could not surrender before the concerned Judicial Magistrate within the stipulated time. Hence the counsel for the petitioner prayed that the time extension for surrender may kindly be granted.

The Learned Public Prosecutor for the state contended that the petition may be allowed subject to the same conditions as stipulated in Cr.M.P.No. 774/2026, dated: 07.05.2026 while granting Anticipatory Bail.

This Court perused the petition and satisfied with the reasons stated therein. Time granted by this Court in the order passed in Cr.M.P.No. 774/2026, dated: 07.05.2026 is further extended till **16.06.2026**. The other conditions stipulated while granting Anticipatory Bail in Cr.M.P.No. 774/2026, dated: 07.05.2026 is remain unaltered. Furthermore time extension shall not be granted.
