This petition coming on this day before me for hearing in the presence of Thiru. R. Selvaraj, Advocate for the petitioner and the Inspector of Police, Kuvagam represented as per the order of the Superintendent of Police, Ariyalur in C.No.366/SB/X/ALR/2026, dated: 02.07.2026 appeared for state and upon hearing both sides and upon perusing the petition and other relevant records, this court delivered the following;

ORDER

This petition has been filed u/s. 482(2) BNSS for relaxation of condition imposed by this court in Cr.M.P.No. 1255/2026, dated 07.07.2026.

The learned petitioner counsel have contended that the respondent police has registered a case against the petitioner for alleged offences Crime No. 308/2026, U/s. U/s. 191(2), 296(b), 118(1), 115(2) of BNS Act 2023 r/w

Sec.3(1)(r), 3(1) (s), 3(2) (va) of SC/ST Act. While this Court granting bail in Cr.M.P.No. 1255/2026, dated 07.07.2026 the petitioner was directed to Ariyalur Police Station, daily at 10.00 A.M until further orders. Further he stated that the petitioner's son is aged 8 years and he is studying 3rd standard in Bharathi Kaliv Nilayam, Elavamalai at Erode and the petitioner alone is keeping her son. Accordingly the petitioner has obeying the condition from 08.07.2026 without any deviation. Hence he prayed for relax the condition.

The respondent police stated that the petitioner have complied the condition for the past 13 days regularly.

This Court perused the rival submissions of both sides. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this Court is of the considered view that the condition imposed on the petitioner can be modified and the petitioner is directed to appear and sign before the **Respondent Police Station on weekly once on every Sunday at 10.00 A.M. for 4 weeks.**
