ORDER

This petition has been filed u/s. 482(2) BNSS for relaxation of condition imposed by this court in Cr.M.P.No. 1004/2026, dated 15.06.2026.

The learned petitioner counsel has contended that the respondent police has registered a case against the petitioners for alleged offences in Crime No.62/2026, U/s. 296(b), 115(2), 118(1) BNS and Sec.4 Tamil Nadu Prohibition

of Harassment of Woman Act r/w. Sec.3 (1) (r), 3(1) (s), 3(2) (va) of SC/ST Act on 04.06.2026. While granting bail in Cr.M.P.No. 1004/2026, dated 15.06.2026 by this court the petitioners were directed to appear and sign before the Respondent Police Station daily at 10.00 A.M until further orders. Hence they prayed for relax the condition.

The respondent police has stated that the petitioners have complying the condition for the past 35 days regularly.

Heard both side. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case, this petition is allowed and the condition stands relaxed fully. The petitioner/ Accused shall be appeared on summon for all the hearings during the trial without fail.
