This petition filed on behalf of the petitioner to release him on bail u/s.483 of BNSS.

This petition is coming on this day for final hearing before this Court in the presence of **Tvl. M. Muniyasamy, K. Sakthivel and M. Kokila**, Advocates for the Petitioners/ Accused and **Thiru. V. Ravichandran, Public Prosecutor**, represented for State, upon perusing the petition submitted and upon hearing both side arguments, this Court pronounced the following:-

**ORDER**

**Heard both side.**

The petitioner is the accused in Crime No.56/2026 of Selvapuram Police Station, for the alleged offence u/s.24(1) of COTPA and 123 of BNS, he has filed this petition, seeking grant of bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner was found in possession of 94 kgs of banned tobacco products for selling to general public. Hence, the present case.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioner is innocent and he is involved in another case and hence, he has been falsely implicated in this case and he never indulged in any such activities as alleged and he is ready to abide any condition and he is in judicial custody for the past 13 days and prays to enlarge the petitioner on bail.

4. Opposing to grant bail to the petitioner, the learned Public Prosecutor submitted that the petitioner is running a grocery shop. In this case, the respondent police seized 94 kgs of banned tobacco products from the petitioner and on enquiry, it came to know that the petitioner kept the same for selling to general public. **Except the present case, the petitioner is involved in four other cases and all the cases are similar in nature.** Investigation is in preliminary stage.

5. After considering the submissions, considering the nature of offence, having regard to the quantum of contraband seized, considering the bad antecedents of the petitioner, as the petitioner has been arrested by the respondent police recently and investigation is in initial stage, this Court is not inclined to grant bail to the petitioner.

**Hence, this petition is dismissed.**
